❖ <u>INTRODU</u>CTION:

National Highway Department has submitted a proposal for diversion of 03.544 ha of forest land for widening to NH 57 i.e. Bolangir to Khordha reach 153/010 to 153/250 and 158/840 to 162/01 K.M. purpose u/s 02 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Forest (Conservation) Rule, 2003. (vii) as stipulated in Stage-I/In-principle Order a Scheme for raising of Avenue Plantation of 12250 nos. of seedlings on both sides of road from Nuagaon to Gochhabari 3 Rkm. and the feeder roads from Sahajpal to Dambarugarh 10 Rkm. and Janhapank to Jagati & Jagati to Telibandh via bank of river Mahanadi over 36 Rkm. has been prepared as per the approved plantation cost norm communicated vide memo no. 18547 dt. 02.11.2021 of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME:

- ➤ To arrest environment pollution, rise of atmospheric temperature due to cutting of trees.
- ➤ To add greenery and maintain aesthetic value along road side.
- ➤ To restocking of the plants against the tree cutting

NAME OF THE PLANTATION SITE:

- Nuagaon to Gochhabari 3 Rkm.
- Sahajpal to Dambarugarh 10 Rkm.
- ➤ Janhapank to Jagati & Jagati to Telibandh via Bank of river Mahanadi over 36 Rkm.

PLANTING TECHNIQUE:

• SURVEY & DEMARCATION:

The area should be surveyed in the field using G.P.S. system. The plantation area to be indicated by sign boards at corners or at point of intersection with roads. The sign boards should contain the name of the plantation site, area, year of planting, planting module, No. of seedlings planted & other details, if necessary.

• ALIGNMENT AND STACKING:

Alignment, stacking and pitting will be taken up in the month of January-February, Pits of size 45 cm X 45 cm X 45 cm will be dug with a spacement of 4 mtrs.

• RAISING OF NURSERY:

Seedlings required for this plantation shall be raised in the Permanent nursery, which is the perennial source of seedling and 10% extra seedlings shall be raised to compensate and mitigate the eventuality of seedling casualty in the nursery. Standard nursery practices shall be followed for raising of seedlings in polythene bags. Permanent gaps need to be assessed well in advance where plantation can be done.

• PLANTING & POST-PLANTING OPERATION:

The road side will be re-stocked by way of raising 12250 nos. plant in Avenue model. Taking into consideration of the soil condition and existing species growing there naturally, the following species are proposed to be planted in dug out pits of 45 cm X 45 cm X 45 cm maintaining a spacing of 4 mt. between the pits. Plantation should be taken up after first regular shower of monsoon and should ideally be completed by

end of July. NPK/DAP fertilizer @ 50 gms per plant should be given as basal dose. Antitermite and insecticide @ 5 gms. per plant should be applied per pit while planting. Casualty replacement whenever required during the planting year and in the subsequent years up to third year should be undertaken for which the seedlings shall be raised and kept in stock at site as well as in the nursery..

• WEEDING, SOIL WORKING AND MANURING:

For establishment and boost up growth of the planted seedlings, weeding, soil working, manuring, soil & water conservation in the form of half moon trenches are necessary. Application of vermi compost shall be given preference. First weeding shall be carried out after the first pair of leaf of the planted species have come up preferably in August. The detailed cost estimate of various operations to be taken up in Avenue plantation has been furnished below.

• PROTECTION:

The important element of successful plantation is Protection. To protect the plantation from grazing and other biotic interference, it will be provided with Iron Wire Mesh Gabion and watchers are to be engaged on daily wage basis for ten years but they should be assigned with specific work and their involvement in protecting the plantation should be ensured. It is suggested not to engage a particular person for the entire ten years but considering the work efficiency of the person, if not found suitable should be replaced.

POINTS OF IMPORTANCE:

While taking up plantation, the following aspects shall be taken up for consideration.

- All care should be taken to raise healthy seedlings of minimum 45cm height and 10% extra of the required stock has to be raised. Pitting shall be invariably done during January-February, when the soil is moist by fall of dew. Planting shall be done at the onset of monsoon.
- ➤ Basal dose of 50 grams of NPK and 5 grams of Bio-pesticide be applied at the time of planting. Casualty replacement, weeding and soil working, application of fertilizer and insecticides shall be taken up as per the provisions made in the cost norm at the proper time. Engaging requisite watchers as per norm is mandatory.
- ➤ All out efforts be taken to keep the plantation free from grazing, fire and other biotic interference.







DGPS survey of identified areas proposed for Compensatory afforestation in Parapat-(A) R.F under Boudh Forest Division in connection with forest areas proposed for diversion for widening to double lane with paved shoulder from Km. 140/000 to 162/01 km. of N.H-57 in Boudh District has been carried out by the user agency through M/s Maptech Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Bhubaneswar.

DGPS survey co-ordinates are verified by ORSAC and compared with the submitted map and found that maps are correct at a confidence level of 95%.

Total area proposed for compensatory afforestation comes in one patch Parapat-(A) R.F under Boudh Forest Division in Boudh District and works out to 7.516 Ha. from submitted .shp files. against the allotted area of 7.5 Ha. (18.533 Ac.) as mentioned in the submitted land schedule.


