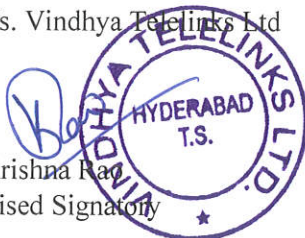

The attention of the District Forest Officer, Peddapally is invited to the references cited. It is informed that in exercise of the powers delegated to the State Government by the Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests, New Delhi in the reference 5th cited, the State Government vide G.O. 6th cited, have **accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval**, for diversion of forest land to an extent of **0.3420 ha** in **Peddapally forest division** of Peddapally District for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of Way in favour of M/s. Vindhya Telelinks Limited, **subject to compliance of conditions stipulated therein**; and requested the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) to take further necessary action in the matter accordingly. A copy of the G.O. 6th cited is communicated herewith.

The District Forest Officer, Peddapally is therefore requested to raise demand note as per the actual rates and submit the demand note to the Nodal Officer on email (ccfcampa.apfd@gmail.com and fcact1980@gmail.com) for vetting. Only after vetting of the demand note by the Nodal Officer, the Forest Divisional Officer should raise demand with the User Agency, who in-turn has to upload the demand online on Ministry's portal, generate Challan & transfer the funds through online only into the specified Ad-hoc CAMPAs account of Telangana State. The detailed procedure for generation of Challan and deposition of funds is available at <https://parivesh.nic.in/> portal.

The mode of remittance for compensatory levies shall be through e-payment portal of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change only as per the guidelines issued by MoEF&CC, GoI (Ad-hoc CAMPAs Wing).

Note: As per the clarification issued by the Ad-hoc CAMPAs Wing vide F.No.13-20/2015-CAMPAs, dt.09.06.2016, the charges for felling, logging, transportation of project affected trees & the funds towards expenditure like boundary walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges etc., if any, should be deposited with the Divisional Forest Officers (now FDOs/DFOs) concerned and the work should be undertaken departmentally in-order to ensure that the task of felling / transportation / stone pillars etc., are undertaken authentically and in the best

interests of the forest. The funds deposited with the District Forest Officer for carrying out such activities should be put to actual utilization only.

In addition to above, District Forest Officer, Peddapally is directed to instruct the User Agency to comply with the following in accordance with the instructions issued by the GoI, MoEF&CC, New Delhi vide F.No.7-23-2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide PCCF's Ref.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt.23.08.2013.

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes in verbatim along with the condition(s) and safe-guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily news paper i.e., one in vernacular language and the other in English.
2. The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in-turn has to display the same for 30 days from the date of receipt of this reference.

The District Forest Officer, Peddapally is specifically directed to obtain and submit condition-wise **compliance report with documentary evidence together with press clipping publishing the entire forest clearances granted to the project proponent through Chief Conservator of Forests/CF, Karimnagar and ensure that (4) sets of condition-wise compliance together with calculation sheet of NPV and other payments details, undertakings, press clipping etc., shall be received in this office, expeditiously, for obtaining Stage-II (final) approval from the competent authority.**

The transfer of forest land to User Agency **shall not be affected** prior to the issue of final approval (or) working permission whichever is earlier.

ORDER:

In the letter 1st read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana State, Hyderabad has submitted a proposal under section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for diversion of forest land to an extent of **0.3420 ha** in **Peddapally forest division** of Peddapally District for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of Way in favour of M/s. Vindhya Telelinks Limited.

2. The proposal has been examined with reference to the guidelines issued by the Government of India in the letter 2nd read above.

3. Government after careful examination of the proposal and in exercise of the powers delegated to State Government in the guidelines issued by Government of India in the letter 2nd read above, hereby accord **in-principle (Stage.I) approval** for diversion of forest land to an extent of **0.3420 ha** in **Peddapally forest division** of Peddapally District for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of Way in favour of M/s. Vindhya Telelinks Limited, subject to compliance of the following conditions:

- i. The legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged;
- ii. **Demarcation of the forest land diverted:** The State Forest Department shall carry out demarcation of the proposed forest area by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of the User Agency and cost for which shall be deposited by the User Agency with the forest department as assessed by the concerned District Forest Officer/ Forest Divisional Officer;
- iii. **No tree felling and branch cutting shall be carried out by the User agency;**
- iv. User Agency shall fulfill the conditions stipulated in Part II, Part III and Part IV and also covering letters, inspections notes of the proposals;
- v. The depth of the trench shall not be more than 2 m and width shall not be more than 0.4 m and after laying down of optical fiber cable the ground shall be leveled. The cable line should be laid atleast one meter below the ground;

- vi. Disturbance should be kept minimum by creating labor camps outside the forest areas and it will be responsibility of the User Agency to ensure that the laborers and staff engaged in execution of work do not destruct nearby forest flora and fauna. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- vii. Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel;
- viii. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government;
- ix. The muck generated in the earth cutting if any, will be disposed off at the designated sites and in no case the muck/ debris will be disposed off in the forest area by the User Agency'
- x. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal;
- xi. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of competent authority;
- xii. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India as well as State Forest Department/ PCCF(HoFF) may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife, shall be complied by the User Agency;
- xiii. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed **0.3420 ha** and the forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal;
- xiv. The User Agency to make good the land after use/ maintenance;
- xv. The User Agency to make good any loss to forests / environment;
- xvi. The User Agency should take permission for carrying out any maintenance;
- xvii. Work should be carried out during day time only;
- xviii. The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance of all the Court orders, provisions, rules, regulations and guidelines for the time being in force as applicable to the project;
- xix. The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).
- xx. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC, Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, Dt.29.01.2018 and as per F.No.5-2/2017, Dt.28.03.2019.

xxi. **Necessary approval shall be obtained from the State Board for wildlife by the User Agency before starting the work.**

3. After receipt of the compliance on the above mentioned conditions, the proposal will be considered for final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of five years from the date of issue of this G.O. in the event of non-compliance of the above conditions, the in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after five years.

4. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad, is therefore, directed to take further necessary action accordingly in the matter.

Jains make amends for slaughtering of animals on Bakrid festivals

EVERY year on the day of Eid-Ul-Adha, popularly known as 'Bakrid', millions of animals, most prominently goats, cows, sheep, buffaloes, camels are slaughtered across the world as an integral part of the Islamic festival. However, the religious approach to mark the occasion is not uniformly unfortunate killing of scores of animals.

To compensate the killing and express sorrow for the slaughtered animals, Jain community around the world go on 'Ayambill' or 'Ayambill', a fast wherein they abstain from eating cereals and non-sprouted pulses once a day.

- Observe 'Ayambill', a fast wherein they only eat cereals and non-sprouted pulses once a day
- Many donate to Jivdaya (animal care), one of important tenets of Jainism

compulsorily observe fast on this day. The idea behind this voluntary penance is to inflict suffering on oneself and share the pain of animals that are slaughtered on Eid-Ul-Adha.



"We do understand that it is an important occasion for the Muslim community and offering sacrifice is a part of it. As Jains cannot stop Muslims from following their religious practices, we compensate the killing of slaughtered animals by observing fast on this day," said a

sadha. However, those who find it difficult to observe fast usually refrain from consuming white food items, most notably milk, ghee and rice, as a mark of their disapproval of the mindless killings of animals on Bakrid. Though abstinence of only white food items is not mandatory, Jains can forego any food items that they want to as a symbolic gesture to oppose the killings of animals. However, white food items have significance as most of the dairy items

are white in colour and on Bakrid, most animals sacrificed are dairy animals. Many who do not follow either of the above practices, that is fast or refrain from consuming white food items, donate to the cause of Jivdaya (animal care), one of the important tenets of Jainism. Donations made are used to prevent cruelty against animals, reduce their suffering by providing them shelter, nutrition water, and healthcare. It also includes rescuing animals from slaughterhouses and abattoirs where they are condemned to live in squalor and filth before being inevitably killed. As a part of Jivdaya, Jains also donate to gashals, the protective shelters meant for the welfare of cows.

Jainism professes equal rights for all living beings regardless of their size, shape, or different spiritual developments.
