

DEMARCATION OF PROPOSED FOREST AREA BY CEMENT CONCRETE PILLARS



No. 0.000 to 61.500 under road connectivity project on left wing extremism area (RCPLWEA) in Tehsil: - Robertsganj, district, Sonbhadra under PMGSY, Uttar Pradesh.

The proposal has been recommended by Chief Wild Life Warden, State Board for Wild Life and State Government.

Decision Taken: After discussion, the Standing Committee decided to recommend the proposal subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The animal passage plan will be prepared by WII.
- The legal status of the land shall remain unchanged. The user agency will have right only for construction, maintenance and use of the road and the land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.
- As forest land and trees standing over it are also involved in the project, Forest Clearance as per provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 will also be required and user agency will be required to comply all conditions stipulated in forest clearance under Forest (Conservation) Act 1980.
- 4. Amount of Net Present Value (N.P.V.) shall be paid by the User Agency as per directions issued by Ministry of Environment of Forest (FC Division), New Delhi vide letter No.F.No.5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009 for proposed forest land 18.00 ha land within Kaimur WLS and its ESZ.
- 5. The user agency shall provide 2% of the proportionate cost of the project falling inside protected area and eco-sensitive zone for mitigation of negative impact and ecological development of wildlife habitat area as per guidelines of Government of India.

MINUTES OF THE 7thMEETING OF THE STATE BOARD FOR WILDLIFE HELD ON 16.11.2022

The 7thmeeting of the State Board for Wildlife was conducted under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 16.11.2022 at 11:00 A.M.

At the outset, the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Environment, Climate Change and Forests Department welcomed the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, Hon'ble Minister for Forests and all Members of the Board.

Following is the gist of discussion

Thiru N.Eramakrishnanan, MLA., Cumbum Assembly Constituency highlighted serious threats to Forest resources due to danger of forest fires. He expressed the need to have an action plan and proper strategy to prevent forest fires. The issues of invasive species was also raised by him. He brought out the fact that invasive species have started to threaten the Bio-diversity in forest areas. Forest Department therefore should act immediately on effective control of invasive species. He was of the opinion that if done properly Forest Department can even generate revenue from removal of exotic and invasive species. Further he requested that the activities of the Tamil Nadu Bio-diversity Conservation and Greening Project should be expanded to the entire State. He expressed concerns about the DGPS survey being under on in border areas by the Kerala Forest Department. He wanted the Tamil Nadu Forest Department to be aware of issues if any in this regard. He spoke about the need to protect the rights of Traditional Forest dwellers and expertise upon speedy action required for granting Forest Rights to Tribal Communities.

Thiru T. Udayasuriyan, MLA., Sankarapuram Assembly Constituency expressed concern about several restrictions on the use of grazing pastures for cattle. He highlighted that earlier grazing Permits were given by the Forest Department in fringe forest areas. However, the same has been restricted now which is the cause of concern. He requested Forest Department to look into these aspects. He also requested that the canal passing through Kalvarayn hills to a length of 2.6 km can be

cleared by the Forest Department. Further basic infrastructure required for the residents of Kalvarayan Hills must be looked into by the Forest Department.

Thiru I.P. Senthil Kumar, MLA., Palani Assembly Constituency appreciated the action taken by Forest Department in removing invasive alien species and replanting the areas with indigenous species. He requested that a joint committee with officials of Forest Department, Water Resource Department and local community may be formed for proper maintenance of water resources / tanks available within forest areas. Roads connecting the tribal hamlets in the forest area to be re-laid and to be maintained properly. He has also requested that old right of way for Tribal Community may be restored.

Tmt. Savithiri Kani requested the Government to regularize the services of Anti-poaching watchers working with the Department for the past several years. She thanked the Government for issuing titles under Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006. She also brought to the attention of board; the difficulties faced by the non-tribal residents of Kalakad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve.

1. Meetings of the State Board for Wild Life need to be conducted regularly. These meetings should be held at least 2-3 times in a year.

- 2. Concerned departments must work together to settle Forest Rights for Tribal Communities through convergence approach. It should be ensured that all bottlenecks are removed to facilitate grant of forest Rights.
- 3. It was clarified that the Government of Kerala and the Government of Tamil Nadu will collaborate and work together to ensure that the DGPS Survey is done without any issues.

The meeting ended with a vote of Thanks to the Chair and other Members.




