The Government of India has accorded In-Principle approval (Stage-I) vide reference 6th cited above, under Forest conservation Act 1980 (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 for diversion of 0.82 ha of Forest Land for Initial Rectification including Widening, Strengthening and Improvements and Performance based maintenance contract for a period of 60 months in State Highways and Major District Roads-Widening of Thiruverumbur Grand Anaicut Road in Thiruvaiyaru(H), Construction & Maintenance Sub-Division.
