2. In this connection, vide reference 2nd cited, the stage-I approval has been received from IRO, MoEF&CC, Chennai for the said project stretch.

3. 5. Vide reference 17th cited, the point wise compliance report also submitted to DFO, Madurai & Dindigul requesting working permission and Stage-II approval. I.A.No.25905 Of 2021:

This application has been filed by the State of Himachal Pradesh to relax the restrictions imposed on diversion of forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 ('FCA') and under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA') vide order dated 11.03.2019 with the following prayers:

(a) relax the restrictions imposed on

diversion of forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006, vide order dated 11.03.2019.

(b) allow the State of Himachal Pradesh to issue formal orders for diversion of forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for construction of 16 projects mentioned in para 8 supra and detailed in Annexure A-5 and all other projects that may be envisaged by the State in future in accordance with the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 or other statutes governing the field.

(c) To allow the State of Himachal Pradesh to issue formal orders for diversion of forest land under Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 for construction of 263 projects mentioned in para 9 supra and detailed in Annexure A-6 and all other projects that may be envisaged by the State in future in accordance with the provisions of Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 or other statutes governing the field.

16 projects referred to in prayer clause (b), the details of which have been given in para 8 of the application, have been approved by FCA. The learned Amicus Curiae Mr. A.D.N. Rao submits that permission can be granted for construction of these 16 projects. In respect of prayer clause (c) which pertains to granting of permission under FRA for construction of 262 projects detailed out in para 9 of the application, the learned Amicus Curiae submitted that permission sought by the State of Himachal Pradesh can be granted subject to an undertaking being filed by the State regarding compensatory afforestation for the area of 191.4121 hectares that requires to be diverted for the said projects.

Permission sought for diversion of the forest land under FCA for construction of 16 projects as mentioned in Para 8 and prayer clause (b), and under FRA for construction of 263 projects mentioned in para 9 and prayer clause (c) is granted subject to the State filing the aforementioned undertaking within a period of four weeks from today.
