2 After careful examination of the proposal of the State Government of Tripura and the additional information submitted vide their letter F.6-1304/FC/For-2021/443-45 dated 13.06.2022 and the recommendation of the Regional Empowered Committee (REC) held on 04.08.2022 and the NBWL conveyed vide letter dated 10.05.2022, the **In-principle / Stage-I** approval of the Central Government is hereby granted for diversion of 14.32 ha of forest land for improvement / widening of road from Jatanbari to Mandirghat via Tirthamukh under District Forest Officer, Gomati by PWD (R&B) Amarpur Division, subject to the following conditions.

A: Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

1. The user agency shall transfer the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted under this proposal as per the Ministry's Guideline No.5-3/2011-FC (Vol.I) dated 06.01.2022 and even No. dated 19.01.2022. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal into CAMPA account of the State concerned.
2. The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with State Forest Department in the account of CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. 7. The cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department:

8. The boundary of the diverted forest land, mining lease and safety zone, as applicable, shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from the pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates:

9. The conditions imposed by the National Board for Wild Life (NBWL) should be complied with and payments shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Government. The conditions imposed are as follows:



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
