
(i)	Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.	Agreed and will be complied.
(ii)	Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 1.86 ha degraded forest land identified in Dhobijhora Block under Kurseong Range of Kurseong Forest Division at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.	Compensatory afforestation has been deposited as ANNEXURE-A
(iii)	The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and at the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years. 




