I, am directed to invite your attention to the reference 3rd cited, in which the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forestry, have accorded approval in-principle (Stage-I) U/s 2 of Forest (C) Act, 1980, for diversion of forest land to an extent of **4.365 ha** (Kamareddy forest division – 1.618 ha + Banswada forest division – 2.452 Ha + Nizamabad Division 0.295 Ha), for laying of Pipe Line and construction of structures for **Segment-11/4 (Mallannagutta)** for providing safe drinking water to Kamareddy and Nizamabad Districts under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Nirmal, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions as stipulated therein.

2. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, in his letter 5th cited, has submitted condition wise compliance report on the conditions stipulated in in-principle (Stage-I) approval. The details of which are as follows:-

The gist of the information on the violation in Segment-11/4 (Mallannagutta) received from the CCF / (FAC) CF, Nizamabad Rc.No. 473/2017/D1, dt. 27.09.2021 is reproduced below:

(a)	When the works are executed, why the Forest Department has not stopped the work.	<p>The FDO/DFO and CCF, Nizamabad have submitted the following:</p> <p>When the works are executed, the Forest Department has not stopped the work because the User Agency has completed the work without obtaining working permission after Stage-I approval. The works are completed during 2017-18. After formation of the New State of Telangana, the Government of Telangana has started a Mission Bhageeratha flag ship programme with the purpose of providing safe drinking water to the Rural and Urban population of the Telangana State. In the inception of the project itself several meetings have been held by the State level officials and District level top officials with the official of the Forest Department and Mission Bhageeratha officials and explained the urgency and importance of the project and instructed not to stop the work as the proposals have already been submitted for diversion. By the time the work is started and completed the stage-I permission was already been accorded. Since the staff at field level kept in mind the importance of the project, urgency and not stopped the work.</p>
(b)	Why show cause notices were issued during 2021, when the works were executed during 2017?	<p>The FDO/DFO and CCF, Nizamabad have submitted the following:</p> <p>A show cause notice was issued to the user agency vide FDO, Nizamabad</p>
