The Conservation Values of Todgarh Raoli Wild Life Sanctuary are the following:

1. The Sanctuary derives its name from the famous historian Colonel James Tod, renowned writer of "Annals and Antiquities of Rajputana" who stayed at the place. This place was named as "Todgarh" by the British.
2. The Sanctuary area covers a large extent of wildlife rich Arawalis in southern Rajasthan with good thriving population of Leopard, Sloth Bear, Hyena, Wolf, Jungle-cat, four horned antelope etc.
3. Exceptional medicinal plant diversity with rare and endangered species is available in various pockets of WLS .
4. Nature awareness, conservation education, ecotourism and research opportunities.
