

Displacement and Resettlement and Rehabilitation- Lakhwar Multipurpose project

- A. Two numbers of villages (Kuna and Ranogi in Tehri Garhwal District) are fully affected while thirty two numbers of villages are partly affected (20 in Tehri Garhwal and 12 in Dehradun District). Identification of the affected families (cutoff date as June 2013) for grant of different benefits according to R & R Policy, on the already acquired land, for which compensation was already paid by UP I.D during acquisition in year 1982-1991, is under process.
- B. Number of families of SC/ST involved in the displacement: 116 ST Families and 0 S.C Families (Verification is under process).
- C. For already acquired land of Lakhwar and Vyasi project, R & R policy of Uttarakhand 2013, decisions of the various meeting held with Hon'ble CM, Uttarakhand and directions issued by GoU in January 2016 along with all the directions of the Government of Uttarakhand shall be followed.

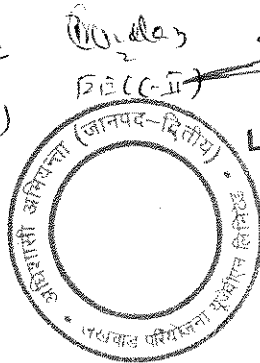
Highlights of Rehabilitation plan are:

- (a) Ex-gratia of Rs. 75 Lacs per hectare.
- (b) Solatium for properties not paid earlier shall be paid.
- (c) Agricultural wages equivalent to 750/500 days of minimum to fully affected/partially affected families
- (d) Permanent employment at class-III posts of project only to project affected people.
- (e) Works up 5.0 lacs of minor technical nature shall be executed through affected families.

A provision of Rs. 24521 Lac has been kept for R & R plan in Revised cost estimate (2019). Balance land shall be acquired as per GoI, Land Acquisition Act- 2013 & GoU R & R policy and directions issued from time to time by GoU.
