PROCEEDINGS

Sub:- Grant of Mining Lease in the Dist. of Dhenkanal.
Read:- Application presented on 6.9.68 by M/s. O.M.C. Ltd., for grant of a Mining Lease for Chromite over an area of 1935.00 acres or 783.07 hectares (available area 1288 acres) in the Dist. of Dhenkanal.

ORDER:

Whereas M/s. O.M.C. Ltd. have applied to the State Government for grant of a Mining Lease by their application read above;

Whereas the mineral in the land in respect of which the Mining Lease has been applied for belongs to Government and the land is at their disposal;

Whereas the applicant holds a valid certificate of approval from the State Government;

Whereas the applicant being a limited company is incorporated;

Whereas the Central Government in exercise of the powers conferred under the proviso to section 6(1) of Mines and Minerals (Regulation & Development) Act, 1957 have approved the grant of the area to M/s. O.M.C. Ltd., in relaxation of provision of Section 6(1) (b) of the Act.

Whereas the Central Government in exercise of the powers conferred under rule 58(2) of the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960 agree to the grant of the above area to M/s. O.M.C. Ltd., in relaxation of provision of Rule 58(1) of Mineral Concession Rules, 1960.;

Whereas the Government of India have conveyed their approval to the grant of Mining Lease under Section 5(2) of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 and also in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 30 of the said Act, directed the State Government to take into consideration this application and pass orders thereon at an early date;

Whereas the Corporation was asked in Mining and Geology Department letter No. 4466/MG. dated 3.5.73 to accept the terms and conditions under which the Mining Lease was proposed to be considered for grant and the party in their letter No. 5914/OMC/73 dated 17.5.73 accepted these conditions;

Therefore, the State Government are hereby pleased to order that a Mining Lease in respect of the land over 1288 acres be granted to Messrs. O.M.C. Ltd., subject to the conditions laid down in the State Government letter No. 4466/MG. dated 3.5.73. The party should comply with all the terms and conditions including furnishing of a surveyed map and description within 3 months from the date of this order to the Collector, Dhenkanal.

in favour of M/S Orissa Mining Corporation Ltd.,

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to your
letter No. 558/mines dated 3.7.76 on the above subject and to
say that M.S Orissa Mining Corporation Ltd, may be allowed to
execute Mining Lease for Chromite over 1440.67 acres or
583.021 Hectares found after final survey and demarcation in
Dhenkanal district for a period of twenty years subject to
the following conditions:-

- (1) The lease should be executed according to the provisions of the Mineral Concession Rules' 1960 and the M & M (R&D) Act' 1957.
- (2) The Mining Lease should be executed within two months from the date of the order;
- (3) The party should erect permanent and pucca boundary pillars around the area, clear up mining dues if any, and deposit security money of Rs. 1000.00 before execution.

The period after expiry of the prescribed time limit of six months may be treated as further period allowed by Government u/r 31(1) of the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960 for the purpose of execution. After execution 3 copies of the Mining Lease deed may be forwarded to Government. Two copies to Director of Mines, Or issa for reference and record. A copy of the model form of mining lease is enclosed and another copy is being sent to the party separately. Copy of the prescribed proforma is enclosed which may be filled in immediately after execution and forwarded to Government.
