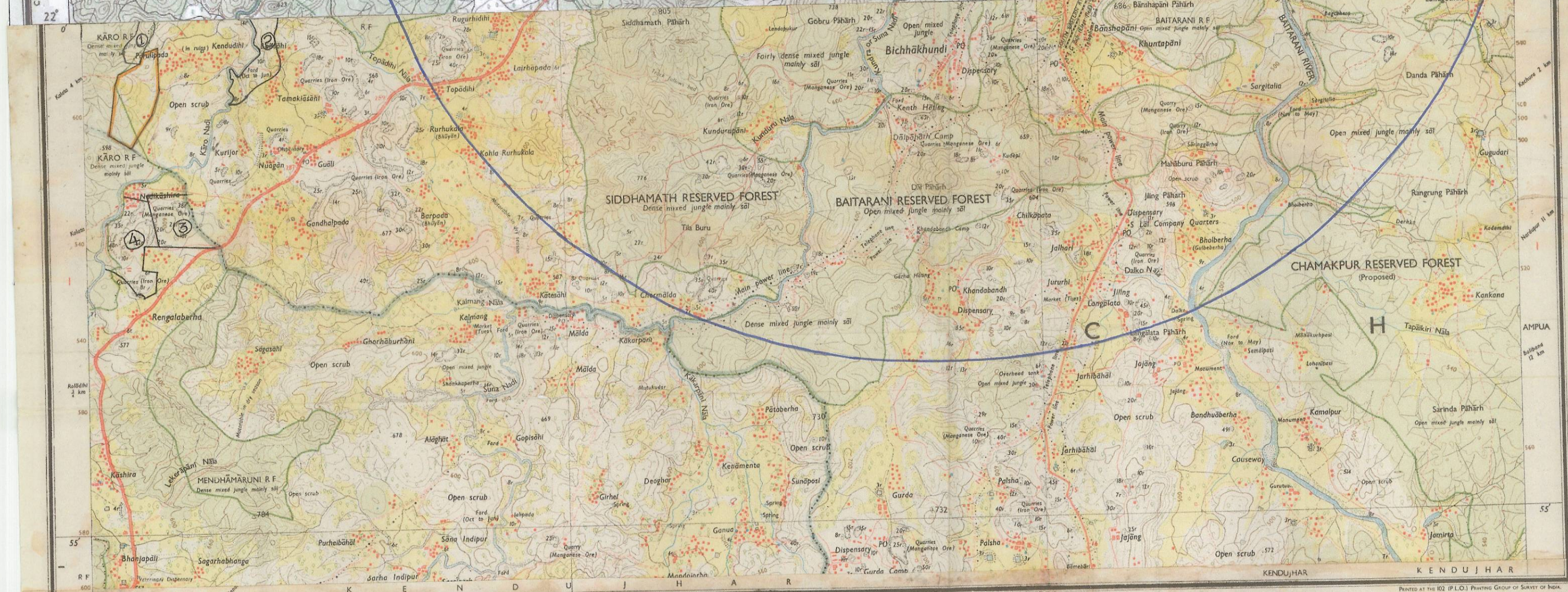
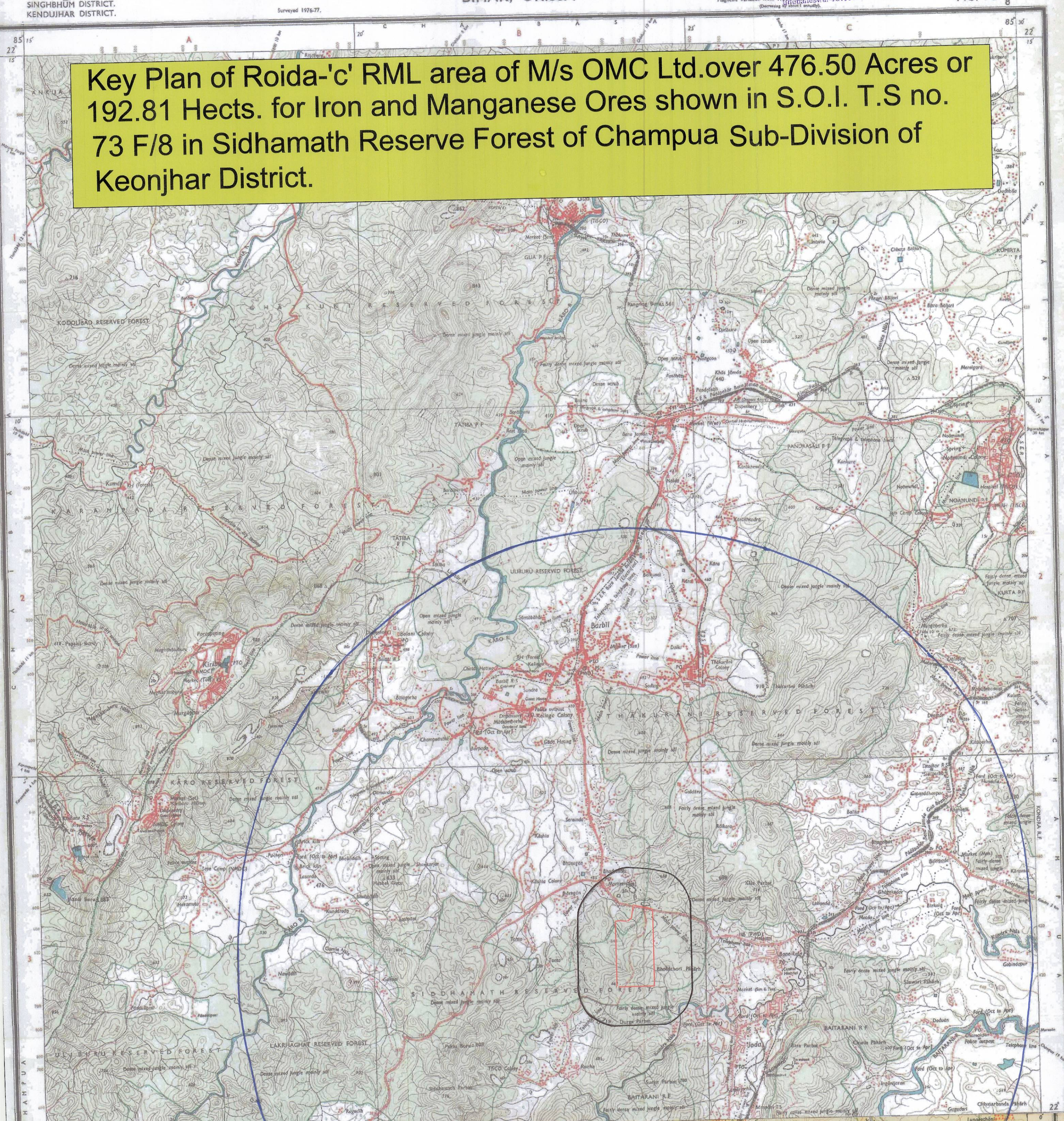

Water features are shown in blue where they generally contain water. Cultivated areas are coloured yellow. The western boundaries of areas of Reserved or Protected Forests are shown by green ribbons.

The district and subdivision boundaries in this sheet have been surveyed as pointed out by the local officials on the ground, but have not been revised by the O.S.D. authorities. The reserved forest boundary of Kijapuri Reserved Forest in squares A/2, 3 has not been shown for lack of reliable information regarding a portion of the boundary. Pines or temporarily cultivated areas occur throughout the jungle in squares A/2, 3 and B/2, 3; they are normally abandoned after 3-5 years and are not shown. The letters P & J are used for Pichhadih Bura Jamsa Ghat Branch.
