Sub: Diversion of 4.90 ha Section-4 Forest land in Block No. 48 Rozinar Jungle, Marine Sanctuary for manufacturing repairing and maintenance of Tugs/Barges of Jamnagar District in favour of Hind Marine Works Jamnagar.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to your letter No. FCA-1017/10-05/17/S.F-57/F dated 24/10/2017 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section – 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. After due consideration of the above proposal of the State Government the undersigned on behalf of the Central Government is hereby directed to convey **In-principle** approval for diversion of 4.90 ha Section-4 Forest land in Block No. 48 Rozinar Jungle, Marine Sanctuary for manufacturing repairing and maintenance of Tugs/Barges of Jamnagar District in favour of Hind Marine Works Jamnagar subject to the following conditions:-

1. Compensatory afforestation :
  - a. Compensatory Afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over **4.90 ha non-forest land** (Survey No. 2118, 2119 & 2120) Village-Hadiyana, Tal-Jodiya, District-Jamnagar at the cost of the User Agency. As far as practicable a mixture of local indigenous species will be planted and monoculture of species has to be avoided.
  - b. The CA plantation shall attracts para 2.4 (vi) of F(C)A, 1980 Handbook, 2019.
  - c. The non forest land shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department.
2. The cost of Compensatory Afforestation, survey, demarcation and erection of pillars shall be deposited in advance at prevailing wage rate with the Forest Department by the User Agency. The CA shall be maintained for 10 years. The scheme shall include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years
3. NPV:
  - a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value(NPV) for the **4.90 ha** forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 01.08.2003, 28.03.2008, 24/04/2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA No. 566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No. 5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II) dated 18.09.2003, as well as letter No. 5-2/2006-FC dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
  - b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of

the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.

c) The NPV shall be dealt in accordance to para 3.4 of F(C)A, 1980 Handbook, 2019.

4. All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited in CAMPA fund only through *e.portal* (<http://parivesh.nic.in>).
5. The cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the user agency with the State Forest Department.
6. The user agency shall obtain the FRA certificate as per six point format of Form-III for non-linear project before Stage-II approval along with gram sabha resolution. The same shall be submitted and uploaded along with compliance report of Stage-I approval.
7. The violation shall be dealt in accordance to para 1.21 of F(C)A, 1980 Handbook, 2019.
8. The user agency shall obtain CRZ clearance before Stage-II approval and the same shall be submitted and uploaded along with compliance report of Stage-I approval.
9. The user agency shall submit Environmental clearance, if applicable.
10. The user agency shall strictly comply with all the conditions given in the wildlife clearance letter of CWLW, Govt. of Gujarat no. WLP/32/B/16391-96/2015-16 dt. 29/03/2016
11. The compliance report in the letter format from Govt. of Gujarat shall be uploaded on *e.portal* (<http://parivesh.nic.in>).

After receipt of compliance report on fulfillment of all the above conditions from the State Government, proposal will be considered for final approval under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

Any order for transfer of forest land to user agency shall not be issued by the State Government till formal approval for diversion of forest land is issued by this office.
