विषय:-In-principle (Stage-I) approval of Central Government under Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 for diversion of 69.178 ha forest land in favour of BSRDC Ltd., PIU-Khagaria-cum-Katihar for widening and upgrading to 2 lanes with paved shoulders of existing SH-99, Baysi-Bahadurganj-Dighalbank Section (Km 0.00 - Km 45.280) road in Purnia and Kishanganj district of Bihar - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to you the Bihar Govt.'s letter No.Van Bhumi-75/2022-21(E)/Pa.Va.Ja.Pa. dated 05.01.2023 and letter No.FC/27/2017-607 dated 25.08.2023 of the APCCF-cum-Nodal Officer (FC), Bihar on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government and on the basis of decision of Regional Empowered Committee in its 67<sup>th</sup> (26.09.2023) meeting, the "**in-principle**" approval of Central Government, is hereby conveyed for diversion of 69.178 ha forest land in favour of BSRDC Ltd., PIU-Khagaria-cum-Katihar for widening and upgrading to 2 lanes with paved shoulders of existing SH-99, Baysi-Bahadurganj-Dighalbank Section (Km 0.00 – Km 45.280) road in Purnia and Kishanganj district of Bihar, subject to the following conditions and stipulations.

A: Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

(1) The cost of compensatory afforestation on the CA land (139 ha) at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme (including the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars etc. as required for securing the land against encroachment) shall be deposited in

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advance with the State Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

- (2) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 69.178 ha forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No. 566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No. 5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II) dated 18/09/2003, as well as letter No. 5-2/2006-FC dated 03/10/2006, 5-3/2007-FC dated 05/02/2009 and letter No.5-3/2011-FC(Vol-I) dated 6/1/2022 in this regard.
- (3) All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred / deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<a href="https://parivesh.nic.in/">https://parivesh.nic.in/</a>).
- (4) The KML files of the area to be diverted and the CA area shall be uploaded on the e-Green watch portal with all requisite details and submitting compliance report for seeking Stage-II approval.
- (5) The FRA certificate as per Ministry's guidelines shall be submitted before the issuance of final approval. The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
- (6) A Muck-Disposal Plan should be prepared by User Agency to ensure that the muck/wastage generated should be disposed of in proper manner. Such plan, duly approved by the concerned DFO, should be submitted to this office before soliciting Working Permission.
- (7) Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of Comprehensive Guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.
- (8) The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (<a href="https://parivesh.nic.in/">https://parivesh.nic.in/</a>).

B: Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the User Agency by the State Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval:

(1) Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.

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- Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 139 ha. degraded forest land (Site 1. Matathan Fullidumar Teliyakhar etc PF, Compartment No. 1802P, 1819P, 1829P (Area: 65 ha) & 2. Katasakara PF, Compartment No. 1319, 1935. (Area: 74 ha) under Kaimur Forest Division) at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local native species shall be planted and monoculture of any species, especially non-native species should be avoided.
- (3) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall also be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- (4) Modern technology will be used to translocate to the extent possible only those trees (having girth less than 60 cm) which are unavoidable and needs to be removed so that minimum numbers of trees are felled.
- (5) User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department. Further, in view of the large number of trees affected for the project, such number of trees whose removal is unavoidable, and whose translocation (species, number and girth to be decided by SFD) is practicable, will be translocated to the extent possible at the cost of user agency.
- (6) The State Forest Department should raise strip plantation on both sides of the road as per the IRC norms.
- (7) (a) The User Agency shall ensure that the labourers and staff engaged in construction activities do not damage the nearby forest flora and fauna.
  - (b) The User Agency shall provide alternate fuels preferably LPG to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.
- (8) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
- (9) (a) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
  - (b) The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of the project life/ requirement.

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- (c) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department, or person without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
- (10) Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forest & wildlife.

After receipt of the report from the State Government regarding due compliance and fulfillment of the above conditions and stipulations, formal approval will be issued in this regard under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. Transfer of forest land by the State Government to the user agency should not be given effect to till formal order approving diversion of forest land is issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change. To facilitate speedy execution of this project, the in-principle approval may be considered for issuance of working permission for commencement of works by the competent authority, if the required funds for NPV and all other compensatory levies specified in the in-principle approval are realized from the user agency and accordingly the State Government, by passing an order, may allow the commencement of work of the linear project in forest land for a period of one year (The detail guideline issued vide Ministry letter No. 11-306/2014-FC, dated 28.08.2015 may be referred).
