Sub: Proposal for diversion of 112.162 Ha of Forest Land for construction of two lane with paved shoulder of Azuram- Mandeu Section from Km 54.180 to Km 80.630 of Tamenglong- Mahur Road in the State of Manipur on EPC mode by NHIDCL.

Sir,

This has got reference to the State Government of Manipur letter No. 27/61/2021-For & Envt dated 29.10.2021on the subject mentioned above seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After careful examination of the proposal of the State Government of Manipur and the additional information submitted vide their letter 27/61/2021-For & Envt dated 25.04.2022 and after recommendation of the proposal in the Regional Empowered Committee (REC) in its meeting held on 27.06.2022, the **In-principle / Stage-I approval** of the Central Government is hereby granted for diversion **112.162 Ha** of Forest Land for construction of two lane with paved shoulder of Azuram-Mandeu Section from Km 54.180 to Km 80.630 of Tamenglong - Mahur Road in the State of Manipur on EPC mode by NHIDCL, subject to the following conditions:

A: Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

1. The user agency shall transfer, the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted under this proposal, as per the Ministry's Guideline No.5-3/2011-FC (Vol.I)dated 06.01.2022 and even No. dated 19.01.2022.The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal into CAMPA account of the State concerned;

2. The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with State Forest Department in the account of CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The scheme may include appropriate for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years;

3. The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising Avenue plantation on the road side in the account of CAMPA of the concerned State only though e-portal;

4. All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA account only though e-portal(https://parivesh.nic.in). Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance;

5. The cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department;

6. The User Agency shall transfer a total of Rs.2.65 Crores for the undertaking various works under the Mitigation Plan i.e. (1) Protection Measures, (2) Habitat Development Programme & (3) Promotion, Propagation & Livelihood Activities recommended by the REC on 27.06.2022 in respect of the 2 (two) Road Projects for construction of two lane with paved shoulder of Azuram-Mandeu Section from Km 54.180 to Km 80.630 & Mandue-Jiri River Section from Km 80.630 to Km 96.870 to the State Forest Department.

7. The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the District Collector;

8. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of comprehensive guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No. 5-2/2017-Fc dated 28.03.2019;

9. Undertaking from the user agency for providing proper drainage of retaining / breast wall in steep slopes and stabilization of side slope to avoid soil erosion and landslides; and to provide drains / cross drains. Physical barriers / structures to prevent muck from entering streams & rivers and other ecologically sensitive areas are to be constructed on the lower slope side, if required, before any construction works are started;

10. The KML files of the area to be diverted, the CA areas shall be uploaded on the e-Green watch portal with all requisite details before issuing work permission towards linear projects or submitting compliance report for seeking Stage-II approval, as the case may be;

11. Undertaking from user agency and State Forest Department regarding proposed avenue plantation with RET species, fruit bearing plants and other native species of ecological and economic importance and that the State Forest Department shall solicit the active participation of JFMC for nursery raising and production of Quality Planting materials for the plantations.

12. The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/);

B: Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the State Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval:

1. Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged;

2. Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised over double degraded forestland identified over 224.324 ha in 5 (five) patches i.e 44.324 ha in Oinamlong Block/Compartment, 40 ha in Oinamlong Block/Compartment, 50 ha in Kailong Compartment, 50 ha in Kailong Compartment all in Tamenglong Forest Division;

3. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government;

4. No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused;

5. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government;

6. The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area;

7. The user agency shall undertake re-grassing of the muck dumping area and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora, fauna etc;

8. The User Agency shall submit the annual self -compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government, concerned Regional Office and to this Ministry by the end of March every year;

9. The user agency shall comply all the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order (s) and NGT Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project;

10. All other clearance/NOCs under different applicable rules/regulations /local laws and under Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights)Act, 2006 as required vide MoEF, New Delhi guideline No.11-9/1998-FC(pt) dated 03.08.2009 shall be complied with;

11. As per Ministry's letter No 11-30/96-FC(Pt) dt 14.9.2001, if the compliance of stipulated conditions is awaited from the State Govt for more than 5(five) years, the in-principle approval would be summarily be revoked considering that the user agency is no longer interested in the project;

3. After receipt of the compliance report from the State Government on fulfillment of the conditions mentioned above, final approval will be issued in this regard. Formal transfer of forest land shall not be effected by the State Govt till final approval is granted by the Central Government.

This is issued with the approval of Deputy Director General of Forests (C).
