Forest & Wildlife Department-Diversion of 0.0062 ha of forest land for the electrification of Annunda area in Malappuram District in Edavanna Range of Nilambur (North) Division under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act,1980-Sanction accorded- Orders issued

ORDER

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (Forest Management) & Nodal Officer, as per letter read above, has recommended and forwarded the proposal in Form A under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act,1980, for diversion of 0.0135 ha of of forest land for electrification of Annunda area in Malappuram District in Edavanna Range of Nilambur (North) Division. The Assistant Engineer, Electrical Section Office, KSEBL, Akambadam is the user agency.

2) The proposal is for providing electricity connection in Annunda Forest area in Akambadam village of Malappuram District. The area comes under the jurisdiction of Nilambur (North) Division. The proposal is beneficial for 3 houses of this area. Inspection reports were submitted by Chief Conservator of Forests (Eastern Circle) Palakkad and Divisional Forest Officer, Nilambur (North) and they have specifically recommended for the project. As per the inspection report, the proposal is to draw 0.225 KMLT Single Phase OH line through the coupe road of Annunda 2005 TP in Pookode Reserve Forest Station in Edavanna Range of Nilambur (North) Division and are not passing through dense forest and no tree felling is required. Chief Conservator of Forest has reported that the total land of utilization is only 0.0062 ha. The requirement of forest land proposed by the User Agency is unavoidable and bare minimum.

3) Government have examined the proposal in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for diversion of 0.0062 ha of forest land for the electrification of Annunda area in Malappuram District in Edavanna Range of Nilambur (North) Division under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act subject to the following conditions:-

1. Legal status of the forest shall remain unchanged.
2. The User Agency shall give undertaking to pay Net Present Value as per guidelines issued by Government of India.
3. The User Agency shall give an undertaking to pay additional Net Present Value if required.
4. The User Agency shall not fell any trees or cause damage to the surrounding

forest and shall take all possible measures to conserve tree growth.

5.The User Agency shall not use the forest land for any purpose other than the purpose for which the forest land is diverted.

6.When the forest land is no longer required for the purpose, the land will be resumed back to the Forest Department.

7.The User Agency shall abide by any other condition imposed later on by Government of India/Government of Kerala/Forest Department in the interest of Forest Conservation.

8.The User Agency has to check the LT Single Phase OH insulated cable in regular interval with permission from Divisional Forest Officer to prevent any danger to wildlife.

9.The User Agency shall apply for renewal of approval after 20 years.

10.The User Agency has to sign an agreement with Divisional Forest Officer, Nilambur (North) incorporating all the conditions imposed by Government of India/Government of Kerala/ Kerala Forest Department in this regard and a nominal lease rent as decided by the Government of Kerala may be remitted.
