विषय: बालाघाट जिले में प्रधानमंत्री ग्राम सड़क योजना (RCPLWE) के अन्तर्गत गोदरी हर्रानाला व्हाया दुगलई तक मार्ग निर्माण हेतु 7.560 हेक्टेयर (1.092 हे. दक्षिण बालाघाट एवं 6.468 हे. उत्तर बालाघाट वनमण्डल) संरक्षित वनभूमि महाप्रबंधक, मध्यप्रदेश ग्रामीण सड़क विकास प्राधिकरण को उपयोग पर देने बाबत (Online Proposal No. FP/MP/Road/156133/2022).

Sir,

This refers to letter No. F-5/1253/2023/10-11/1905 dated 12/05/2023, 4163 dated 15/09/2023 and 131 dated 05/01/2024, PCCF/ APCCF (LM), Nodal Officer, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government and on the decision of Regional Empowered Committee in its 2nd meeting of 2024 on 29/01/2024, the "in-principle" approval of the Central Government, is hereby conveyed for diversion of 7.560 ha (1.092 ha South Balaghat & 6.468 ha North Balaghat Forest Division) Protected Forest land for construction of Godri Harranala via Dugali Road under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojna (RCPLWE) in favour of General Manager, Madhya Pradesh Rural Road Development Authority in Balaghat District of Madhya Pradesh, subject to following conditions and stipulations:

Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the A: State Forest Department

Cost of compensatory afforestation on the 15.12 ha (out of 19.347 ha) Chhote-Bade Jhad ka Jungle at prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme (including cost (1) of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars etc. as required for securing the land against encroachment) shall be deposited in advance with the State Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provisions for anticipated cost increase for the works scheduled for subsequent

Chhote-Bade Jhad ka Jungle land shall be transferred and mutated in favour of State Forest department and documents shall be submitted.

- Chhote-Bade Jhad ka Jungle land which is transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department for the purpose of compensatory afforestation shall be (3)declared as Reserved Forest under Section-4 or Protected Forest under Section-29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 or under the relevant Section(s) of the State Forest Act. A Copy of the same may be submitted in Stage-I compliance report.
- The State Government shall charge Net Present Value (NPV) for the **7.560** ha forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per orders of the Hon'ble Supreme (4)

Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No. 566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No. 5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II) dated 18/09/2003, as well as letter No. 5-2/2006-FC dated 03/10/2006, 5-3/2007-FC dated 05/02/2009 & 5-3/2011-FC(Vol-I) dated 06/01/2022 in this regard.

- (5) All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred / deposited in CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<u>https://parivesh.nic.in/</u>).
- (6) Complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
- (7) All conditions of CWLW/SBWL/NBWL shall be strictly complied, wherever applicable.
- (8) Despite repeated requests, the site inspection report is not being provided by the concerned CF. It seems that the concerned CF is not aware of the sensitivity of the proposals. Concerned CF will himself inspect all the routes and submit a report as desired by the Regional Empowered Committee (REC) along with the compliance report. If any changes are required in accordance with his report, they shall be incorporated and proposal amended accordingly.
- (9) The concerned DFO shall examine the forest area proposed for diversion along with KML prepared for the same and submit a certificate about correctness of the KML file as per field conditions and updated Working Plan forest boundary. It shall also be certified that, the village along the proposed alignment is a notified revenue village outside the forest boundary as per the updated working plan boundary.
- (10) The User agency shall submit road side plantation scheme in consultation with the State Forest Department and the plantation shall be carried out by SFD at the cost of User Agency.
- (11) The User Agency shall submit an undertaking that no muck shall be disposed off in forest land.
- (12) The KML files of Diverted and CA areas shall be uploaded on the e.Green watch portal with all requisite details prior to Stage-II Approval.
- (13) Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of Comprehensive Guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.
- (14) The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (<u>https://parivesh.nic.in/</u>).
 - (15) In case working permission is granted by the State Forest Department, a copy of the same shall be submitted with compliance report of Stage-I approval.
 - B: Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the User Agency by the State Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval:
 - (1) Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
 - (2) Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 15.72 ha (out of 19.347 ha) Chhote-Bade Jhad ka Jungle at Khasra No. 08, Village- Bagholi, Tehsil-Baraseoni, Tehsil- Paraswada, District-Balaghat at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local native species shall be planted and monoculture of any species, especially non-native species shall be avoided.
 - (3) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from

the Expert Committee, shall also be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.

- (4) The User Agency shall restrict felling of trees to the enumerated 15 numbers/minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department or the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department and State Forest Department shall undertake the fellings.
- (5) Boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on the ground at the project cost.
- (6) User agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road as per the IRC norms.
- (7) Speed regulating signages will be erected all along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/ Forest Areas.
- (8) Layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of the Central Government.
- (9) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- (10) The User Agency shall provide alternate fuels preferably LPG to the labourers and staff working at the site so as to prevent any damage and pressure on the nearby forests.
- (11) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- (12) The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the project life.
- (13) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- (14) The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of all the Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order(s) and National Green Tribunal Order(s) pertaining to this project, if any for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
- (15) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Central Government.
- (16) Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forest & wildlife.

After receipt of the compliance report regarding fulfillment of the conditions as stipulated above, from the State Government, formal approval will be issued in this regard under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

This has been issued with the approval of competent authority.
