ORDER:

In his letter 1st read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad has submitted a proposal for diversion of forest land to an extent of 0.83 ha in Karimnagar (East) Division and 0.43 ha in Warangal (North) division, totaling 1.26 ha for laying of Optical Fiber Cable all along the road within existing right of way in favour of M/s Idea Cellular Limited.

2. Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad, and in the light of the guidelines issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests, in the letters 2nd to 4th read above, hereby accord permission to the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telagana State, Hyderabad, for diversion of forest land to an extent of 0.83 ha in Tadicherla, Medipally and Manthani Reserve Forests in Karimnagar (East) division and 0.43 ha in Mallampally (0.17 ha), Tadicherla (0.16 ha) and Bhagirthipet (0.10 ha) Reserve Forests in Warangal (North) division, **totaling 1.26 ha** for laying of Optical Fiber Cable all along the road within existing right of way in favour of M/s Idea Cellular Limited, subject to fulfillment of the following parameters / conditions:-

- i. The proposed work should be carried out without felling of trees.
- ii. The maximum size of the trench is 2.00 mtrs depth and 1.00 mtr width.
- iii. Laid out along the road and within the existing right of way
- iv. The User Agency to make good the land after use/ maintenance.
- v. The User Agency to make good any loss to forests / environment.
- vi. The User Agency should take permission for carrying out any maintenance.
- vii. The User Agency should pay compensation for the felled & damaged trees, if any.

(PTO)

- viii. The User Agency shall erect 50 No. of awareness / publicity boards. The design & specifications will be provided by the Forest Department and the cost of design erection, installation, transport etc., will be borne by the User Agency;
- ix. In order to create more awareness on nature, the User Agency shall setup (2) Environment learning & interpretation centre, one in Manthani Range and One in Bhupalpally (E) Range. The design, specifications & Estimates will be provided by the Forest Department at the time of compliance and the cost of constructions & all other costs are to be borne by the User Agency;
- x. The User Agency should not disturb flora and fauna during the execution of the project;
- xi. The User Agency should follow FCA, 1980 strictly.
3. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad shall take necessary action, accordingly.


