ORDER

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forest(Forest Management) & Nodal Officer as per the letter read above has recommended and forwarded a proposal for diversion of 0.0106 ha of forest land under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act,1980 for electrification of Peruvampadam area in Malappuram District in Edavanna Range of Nilambur (North) Division. The Assistant Engineer, Electrical Section Office, KSEBL Akambadam is the User Agency. The proposal is beneficial for 2 houses of this area.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord in principal (stage I) approval under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for the above proposal subject to the following conditions:-

1. Legal status of the forest shall remain unchanged.
2. The User Agency shall give undertaking to pay Net present Value as per guidelines issued by Government of India.
3. The User Agency shall give an undertaking to pay additional Net present Value if required.
4. The User Agency shall not fell any trees or cause damage to the surrounding forest and shall take all possible measures to conserve tree

growth.

5. The User Agency shall not use the forest land for any purpose other than the purpose for which the forest land is diverted.

6. When the forest land is no longer required for the purpose, the land will be resumed back to the Forest Department.

7. The User Agency shall abide by any other condition imposed later on by Government of India of India/Government of Kerala/ Forest Department in the interest of Forest Conservation.

8. The User Agency has to check the LT Single Phase OH line in regular interval with permission from Divisional Forest Officer to prevent any danger to wildlife.

9. The User Agency shall apply for renewal of approval after 20 years.

10. The User Agency has to sign an agreement with Divisional Forest Officer, Nilambur (North) incorporating all the conditions imposed by Government of India/ Government of Kerala/Kerala Forest Department in this regard and the nominal lease rent as decided by the Government of Kerala may be remitted.
