ORDER:

In the letter 1st read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana State, Hyderabad has submitted a proposal for diversion of 0.583 Ha of forest land in Hyderabad Division for laying of Optical Fiber Cable in the existing Right of Way in favour of M/s Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited.

- 2. Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana State, Hyderabad, and in the light of the guidelines issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests, in the references 2nd to 4th read above, hereby accord permission to the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Telagana State, Hyderabad, for diversion of 0.583 Ha of forest land in Narepally I, Medipally I, Kandlapally, Annanthagiri, Dharur, Duggapur and Regondi Kondapur Reserve Forests, Hyderabad Division for laying of Optical Fiber Cable in the existing Right of Way in favour of M/s Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited, subject to fulfillment of the following parameters / conditions:
 - i. The proposed work should be carried out without felling of trees.
 - ii. Laid along the road and within the existing right of way.
 - iii. The maximum size of the trench is 2.00 mtrs depth and 1.00 mtr width.
 - iv. The User Agency to make good the land after use / maintenance.
 - v. The User Agency to make good any loss to forests / environment.
 - vi. The User Agency should take permission for carrying out any maintenance.
 - vii. The User Agency should pay compensation for the felled & damaged trees, if any.

3. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana State, Hyderabad shall take necessary action accordingly in the matter.
