Sub: - **Diversion of 2.44215 ha. fo Forest Land for laying of OFC along on Tapa-to Uggoke road KM 5.750-12.500R/s, Dhanoula-Bhikhi road KMO-17L/s, Barnala-Dhuri road KMO-12 R/s, Dhuri-Mullowal road KMO-18L/s, under forest Divison Sangrur & Distt. Sangrur & Barnala.**

Ref: - Your letter No.7515 dated 08-02-18

Government of India has accorded general approval under the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 vide letter No. 11-9/98-FC dated 08-04-2009 dated 02.02.2015 in the cases of laying of Underground Telephone Lines, Optical Fiber Cable/Underground Laying of Drinking Water Supply Pipeline.

After careful consideration of the proposal submitted vide your letter under reference general approval of Govt. of India under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for "In-Principle-Approval" of temporary diversion of **2.44215 ha** of forest land for digging of trenches measuring **53750** mtrs. long and **0.45** mtrs. wide along the road for laying of Optical Fiber Cable is hereby conveyed (**Vindhya Telelink Limited**) with directions for strict compliance of the orders of the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal New Delhi Dated 19.05.2016 in O.A. 161 & O.A. 162 of 2016 Dr. Amandeep Aggarwal V/s State of Punjab & Others and Peacock Environment & Wildlife V/s State of Punjab & Others subject to the following conditions:

1. Legal status of the forest land will remain unchanged.
2. The forest land will not be used for any other purpose.
3. No tree will be felled.
4. Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide order dated 28-3-08 in I.A No. 826 in 566 in W.P.(C) 202 of 1995 has fully exempted NPV provided: (a) no felling of trees is involved; and (b) the areas fall outside National Park/Wildlife Sanctuary.
5. User Agency has given Bank Guarantee of **Rs. 13,43,750/-** to DFO, Sangrur.
6. The Optical Fiber Cable will be laid along the road within the existing right of way and close to the outermost edge of the forest land. The dug out land shall be restored by the User Agency and the same shall be made good immediately after the approved operation.
7. This approval is subject to the clearance of the proposal under relevant local Acts/Rules/Court's Rulings/instructions etc. as applicable.
8. The User Agency shall seek prior permission from the DFO, Sangrur for carrying out any maintenance operation.
9. The User Agency shall abide by any other condition (s) that may be imposed by this Department in the interest of afforestation and protection of environment.
10. The State Forest Department may revoke/suspend this approval, if any of the above conditions is not satisfactorily fulfilled by the User Agency.
11. An undertaking is signed by the User Agency for abiding by all the aforesaid conditions.
12. If any other NOC is necessary under any Act/Rules/Guidelines etc. from other Departments, the user agency should obtain the same before the commencement of laying of Cable.
13. **The user agency shall provide certificate regarding Scheduled Tribes and Traditional Forest Dwellers Recognition of Forest Rights Act, 2006 from the concerned Deputy Commissioner to Divisional Forest Officer. The use of forest land will not be allowed till final approval is accorded.**
14. CF, South Circle/DFO, Sangrur shall ensure fulfillment of the above conditions.
