महोदय,

कृपया उपरोक्त विषयक सचिव (वन), उत्तर प्रदेश शासन के पत्रांक पी-350/81-2-2021-800(289)/2021 दिनांक 22.12.2021 का आशय ग्रहण करने का कष्ट करें, जिसके द्वारा विषयांकित प्रकरण में राज्य सरकार द्वारा वन (संरक्षण एवं संवर्धन) अधिनियम, 1980 के अन्तर्गत भारत सरकार की स्वीकृति मांगी गयी थी।

प्रश्नगत प्रकरण में इस कार्यालय के समसंख्यक पत्र दिनांक 16.06.2022 द्वारा कतिपय शर्तों के साथ सैद्धांतिक स्वीकृति प्रदान की गई थी, जिसकी अनुपालना उपरोक्त संदर्भित पत्रों के माध्यम से प्रेषित की गई है। प्रस्तुत अनुपालना के परीक्षणोपरान्त मुझे आपको यह सूचित करने का निर्देश हुआ है कि केन्द्र सरकार उत्तर प्रदेश एक्सप्रेसवेज इण्डस्ट्रियल डेवलेपमेंट अथारिटी (यूपीडा) द्वारा गंगा एक्सप्रेसवे परियोजना के निर्माण में जनपद अमरोहा में प्रभावित 1.68 हे० आरक्षित वनभूमि एवं बाधक 3629 वृक्षों के पातन, प्रतापगढ़ में प्रभावित 1.0749 हे० संरक्षित वनभूमि एवं बाधक 2716 वृक्षों के पातन, रायबरेली में प्रभावित 23.552 हे० आरक्षित वनभूमि तथा 6.1746 हे० संरक्षित वनभूमि एवं बाधक 47258 वृक्षों के पातन, उन्नाव में प्रभावित 61.3621 हे० आरक्षित वनभूमि तथा 6.4218 हे० संरक्षित वनभूमि एवं बाधक 106144 वृक्षों के पातन, हापुड में प्रभावित 2.0342 हे० संरक्षित वनभूमि एवं बाधक 839 वृक्षों के पातन, बदायू में प्रभावित 4.9257 हे० संरक्षित वनभूमि एवं बाधक 1554 वृक्षों के पातन, शाहजहापुर में प्रभावित 3.907 हे० संरक्षित वनभूमि एवं बाधक 865 वृक्षों के पातन, सम्भल में प्रभावित 4.052 हे० संरक्षित वनभूमि एवं बाधक 4023 वृक्षों के पातन एवं हरदोई में प्रभावित 4.0551 हे० आरक्षित वनभूमि तथा 2.2322 हे० संरक्षित वनभूमि एवं बाधक 138 वृक्षों के पातन अर्थात् परियोजना में प्रभावित 90.6492 हे० आरक्षित वनभूमि तथा 30.8224 हे० संरक्षित वनभूमि कुल 121.4716 हे० वनभूमि के गैरवानिकी प्रयोग एवं बाधक 167166 वृक्षों/पौधों के पातन की विधिवत् स्वीकृति निम्नलिखित शर्तों पर प्रदान करती है :-


1. Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department in an area of **94.4662 ha.** (NFL) Non Forest Land in Districts Amroha, Hardoi, Unnao, Raibareilly and **62.00 ha.** Degraded Forest Land in District Chitrakoot at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided. The details of area for CA is as follows:-

3. Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over by the user agency.
4. The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
5. User agency shall restrict the felling of trees to the enumerated 167166 trees/any minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
6. The user agency shall provide suitable under / over pass in Protected Area / Forest Area as per recommendations of CWLW / NBWL / FAC / REC.
7. Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/Forest Areas.
8. The User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
9. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
10. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
11. The User Agency shall provide alternate fuels preferably LPG to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.
12. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
13. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
14. **Since the stretch of this Expressway is through the districts along river Ganga thus the Forest Department shall submit a management plan for conservation of Gangetic Dolphin at the cost of user agency.**

15. Plantation shall be raised on both sides of the road and median (if available) at the cost of User Agency according to IRC guidelines and order passed by NGT in OA no. 27/2015 in the matter of Babulal Jaju v/s State of Rajasthan and others dated 16.11.2015.
16. The non forest land proposed for CA under Unnao division shall be rectified in DSS Portal of FSI.
17. The user agency will ensure that while constructing the road, the hydrological regimes of the area through which the proposed road is passing, would not be adversely affected on account of creation of artificial barriers for wetlands/waterbodies and stoppage for natural flow of waters, seasonal drains, channels and streams. The flow of water in the micro watersheds shall remain undisturbed throughout the year and there would be no stagnation of water along the road. The user agency will submit a detailed plan in this regard approved by the concerned DFO.
18. The period of diversion under this approval shall be for 99 years or co-terminus with the period of the project life, whichever is earlier.
19. The State Government shall ensure necessary action subsequent to any change in forest area/forest boundary after completion of digitization.
20. DFO shall ensure that the area proposed for diversion is as per the existing Working Plan and no other affected forest area is left to be included in the proposal.
21. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
22. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India.
23. The KML file of area proposed for diversion and area proposed for plantation shall be uploaded on the E-Green watch portal with all requisite details before commencement of works.
24. Annual 3rd party monitoring and concurrent internal monitoring by State Forest Department shall be done and monitoring reports submitted to this office.
25. The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance of all the Court orders, provisions, rules, regulations and guidelines for the time being in force as applicable to the project.
26. Project Completion Report and Stage-II compliance report shall be submitted within a period of 6 months of completion of project.
27. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and action would be taken as per para 1.16 of consolidated guideline and clarifications on Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023, MoEF&CC and as amended from time to time.
28. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
29. This approval is subject to the final outcome with respect to Hon'ble Supreme Court Orders in the CWP (C) No 1164/2023 dated 3.2.2025 and 4.3.2025.



1. The Commission has received a request from the State of New York for a review of the proposed amendments to the Environmental Conservation Law (ECL) and the Environmental Conservation Regulations (ECR) relating to the discharge of pollutants into navigable waters.

2. The Commission has reviewed the proposed amendments and has concluded that they are necessary to protect the public health, safety and the environment.

3. The Commission has also reviewed the comments of interested parties and has taken them into account in its final decision.

4. The Commission has determined that the proposed amendments are in the public interest and should be adopted.

5. The Commission has recommended that the proposed amendments be adopted by the State Legislature.

6. The Commission has also recommended that the State Legislature take certain steps to ensure the effective implementation of the proposed amendments.

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
