Subject:Diversion of 6.073 ha. of forest land in Sy. No. 40, Guduginakoppa village and Sy.No. 103 and 164, Udri village, Kasaba Hobli, Soraba Taluk, Shivamogga District (Sagar Forest Division) for laying of 110 KV S/C line on DC Towers from the existing 110/11 KV Thogarsi Substation to the proposed 1x10 MVA 110/11 KV Substation at Kuppagudde in Soraba Taluk, Shivamogga District in favour of the Executive Engineer (Electrical), Major Works Division, Karnataka Power Transmission Corporation Ltd (KPTCL), Shivamogga (Online Proposal No. FP/KA/TRANS/38788/2019) - reg.

Sir,

Please refer to the State Government's letters No. FEE 44 FLL 2020 (e) dated 05/02/2021 and 04/05/2022 seeking prior approval of the Central Government in accordance with Section'2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in respect of the above project. The in-principle (Stage-I) approval to the project was accorded by the Central Government vide letter of even number dated 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2022. The State Government vide letter No.FEE 44 FLL 2020 (e) dated 05/02/2025 and 03/09/2025 have reported compliance to the conditions stipulated by the Central Government in the in-principle approval.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government, I am directed to convey Central Government's final approval (Stage-II) under Section '2(1)' of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 for diversion of 6.073 ha. of forest land in Sy. No. 40, Guduginakoppa village and Sy.No. 103 and 164, Udri village, Kasaba Hobli, Soraba Taluk, Shivamogga District (Sagar Forest Division) for laying of 110 KV S/C line on DC Towers from the existing 110/11 KV Thogarsi Substation to the proposed 1x10 MVA 110/11 KV Substation at

Kuppagudde in Soraba Taluk, Shivamogga District in favour of the Executive Engineer (Electrical), Major Works Division, Karnataka Power Transmission Corporation Ltd (KPTCL), Shivamogga, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 2. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost as per the directions of concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 3. Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised over double the extent of degraded forest land identified in Sy.No. 70, Thadasalli village, Muttagi Minor Forest, Udagani Hobli, Shikaripura Taluk, Shivamogga District, within two years from the date of Stage –II Clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department at the cost of the User Agency and at least 1000 plants per hectare shall be planted over identified degraded forest land.
- 4. Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from the user agency
- 5. If any claims under FRA are recognized by the competent authority in the encroached area, the User Agency shall compensate such claims as per law.
- 6. Tree felling shall be restricted to the barest minimum possible and under confirmation from the local forest officials.
- 7. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
- 8. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 9. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 10. Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 11. The user agency at its cost shall provide bird deflectors, which are to be fixed on upper conductor of transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits.
- 12. The User Agency shall comply with the guidelines for laying transmission lines through forest areas issued by Ministry vide letter No.7-25/2012-FC dated 05/05/2014 & 19/11/2014.
- 13. Plantation of dwarf species (preferably medicinal plants) in the right of way under the transmission line shall be taken up at the cost of the User Agency.
- 14. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- 15. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
- 16. No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.
- 17. User Agency shall obtain the Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
- 18. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.

- 19. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 6.073 ha.
- 20. The concerned Divisional Forest Officer will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.
- 21. The User Agency shall submit the annual self-compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government and Integrated Regional Office, Bengaluru by the end of March every year.
- 22. Any other condition that the Central Government may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of Forest and Wildlife.
- 23. The State Government and user agency shall comply the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT order & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
- 24. The conditions required to be adhered under the Forests Right Act, 2006 as per the guidelines issued under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 shall be strictly complied with.
- 25. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed under the Act, Rules and Guidelines relevant.
