Forests – Vellore Forest circle/ Thiruvannamalai Forest Division – Diversion of 0.32 ha of forest land in Moolakkadu and Pattarakkadu Reserved Forests in Tiruvannamalai Forest Division for construction of retaining wall in various places of Polur – Jamunamarathur - Alangayam-Vaniyambadi Road from km 18/4 to 26/10 of SH-215 in Tiruvannamalai District, in favour of Divisional Engineer, Highways, Construction and Maintenance, Tiruvannamalai District under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter first read above has furnished the proposal for diversion of 0.32 ha of forest land in Moolakkadu and Pattarakkadu Reserved Forests in Tiruvannamalai Forest Division for construction of retaining wall in various places of Polur – Jamunamarathur – Alangayam -Vaniyambadi Road from km 18/4 to 26/10 of SH-215 in Tiruvannamalai District, in favour of Divisional Engineer, Highways, Construction and Maintenance, Tiruvannamalai District under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. In the Government letter second read above, the Government have conveyed the State Government's in-principle approval (Stage-I) under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.32 ha of forest land in Moolakkadu and Pattarakkadu Reserved Forests in Tiruvannamalai Forest Division for construction of retaining wall in various places of Polur – Jamunamarathur – Alangayam - Vaniyambadi Road from km 18/4 to 26/10 of SH-215 in Tiruvannamalai District, in favour of Divisional Engineer, Highways, Construction and Maintenance, Tiruvannamalai District for a period of 25 years under general approval category as per the provisions of guidelines under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for critical development initiatives for public utility, subject to certain conditions and requested to furnish the compliance report after satisfying all the conditions stipulated therein within a period of 5 years.

3. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter third read above has furnished the compliance report in respect of the conditions stipulated in the Stage-I approval accorded for the said proposal and also stated that User Agency has completed the demarcation of the proposed forest area by erecting 4-feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters and has remitted an amount of Rs.2,00,320/- towards Net Present Value in State CAMPA (Campa Afforestation Fund

Management and Planning Authority) Fund. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has also requested to issue final (Stage-II) approval under General approval category, for diversion of 0.32 ha of forest land in Moolakkadu and Pattarakkadu Reserved Forests in Tiruvannamalai Forest Division for construction of retaining wall in various places of Polur – Jamunamarathur – Alangayam - Vaniyambadi Road from km 18/4 to 26/10 of SH-215 in Tiruvannamalai District, in favour of Divisional Engineer, Highways, Construction and Maintenance, Tiruvannamalai District, for a period of 25 years under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

4. The Government after careful examination, accord the State Government's final (Stage-II) approval under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.32 ha of forest land in Moolakkadu and Pattarakkadu Reserved Forests in Tiruvannamalai Forest Division for construction of retaining wall in various places of Polur – Jamunamarathur – Alangayam - Vaniyambadi Road from km 18/4 to 26/10 of SH-215 in Tiruvannamalai District, in favour of Divisional Engineer, Highways, Construction and Maintenance, Tiruvannamalai District for a period of 25 years under general approval category for critical development initiatives for public utility, subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
- ii. The User Agency has to bear the additional amount of Net Present Value, which will be fixed as per the guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India as fixed by Forest Department in future.
- iii. The User Agency has to pay the cost towards lease rent as fixed by the Forest Department at the time of sanction along with any escalation for the forest land to be diverted for the above project in future for the entire project period.
- iv. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 0.32 ha.
- v. Period of lease can be twenty five (25) years. The User Agency has to apply renewal proposal before one year of expiry of lease with the State Forest Department.
