Order :

Whereas, the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State, Nagpur, vide his letter under reference No.1 has submitted a proposal to the State Government, which was received from the Executive Engineer, EHV Project Division, Kalyan for diversion of 0.7 ha. forest land under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for construction of LILO on existing 220 KV Boisar Nallasopara Transmission Line for Palghar Substation at Morekuran, Tal. & Dist. Palghar.

AND whereas, Government of Maharashtra after due consideration, vide its order under reference No. 2 accorded 'In-Principle' approval with certain conditions to above proposal for diversion of 0.7 ha. forest land under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980;

AND whereas, the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State, Nagpur, vide letter under reference No. 3 has submitted compliance of those conditions to the Government of Maharashtra;

NOW, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred to State Government under general approval granted vide MoEF&CC, Government of India's Handbook of Guidelines for effective and transparent implementation of the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 [Chapter-4, Para-4.3], Government of Maharashtra is pleased to grant **Final Approval** for diversion of 0.7 ha. Forest Land for construction of LILO on existing 220 KV Boisar Nallasopara Transmission Line for Palghar Substation at Morekuran, Tal. & Dist. Palghar.

Therefore, the Government of Maharashtra directs that 0.7 ha. Forest Land consisting of Reserved Forest Land more specifically described in the proposal submitted vide letter under reference No.1 and mentioned in the Schedule given below, be diverted to the User Agency, i.e. Executive Engineer, EHV Project Division, Kalyan for construction of LILO on

existing 220 KV Boisar Nallasopara Transmission Line for Palghar Substation at Morekuran, Tal. & Dist. Palghar. This approval for diversion of forest land is subject to compliance of following conditions by the User Agency-

1. The diversion shall be effected subject to the terms and conditions mentioned in the 'In-Principle' approval order dated 08.08.2022.
2. The User Agency shall comply with all the conditions stipulated in the above mentioned 'In-Principle' and in this order of Government of Maharashtra. The Chief Conservator of Forests (Territorial), Thane shall ensure the strict compliance of the conditions by the User Agency. CCF will furnish the report in this regard to Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State, Nagpur from time to time.
3. Non-compliance of any of the conditions mentioned in Government of Maharashtra's order dated 08.08.2022, in this order and Rules and Guidelines made / issued under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, shall amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken accordingly.
4. In case of non-compliance of any of the above conditions, the concerned Chief Conservator of Forests / Deputy Conservator of Forests shall report through the State Government to Regional Officer (Central), Integrated Regional Office, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, Nagpur as per procedure laid down in the guidelines under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
