

## PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub: Diversion of 0.0978 hectare of forest land in Kurkunda Village Sy. No. 202, Mallat Hobli, Manvi Taluk, Raichur District for construction of Main Balancing Tank, Approach Road (3.15 m width) and laying of 150 mm Dia Water Pipeline under Combined Water Supply Scheme to Mallat and 10 other Villages in Manvi Taluk of Raichur District in favour of the Executive Engineer, Rural Drinking Water Supply and Sanitation Department, Raichur.

## **Preamble:**

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) Bengaluru vide letter read (1) above has submitted the proposal to obtain Stage-I approval under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for Diversion of 0.0978 hectare of forest land in Kurkunda Village Sy. No. 202, Mallat Hobli, Manvi Taluk, Raichur District for construction of Main Balancing Tank, Approach Road (3.15 m width) and laying of 150 mm Dia Water Pipeline under Combined Water Supply Scheme to Mallat and 10 other Villages in Manvi Taluk of Raichur District in favour of the Executive Engineer, Rural Drinking Water Supply and Sanitation Department, Raichur.

The State Government has accorded Stage-1 approval under the Forest(Conservation) Act, 1980 by stipulating certain conditions vide letter read at (2) above.

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Forest Conservation) & Nodal Officer (FCA) Bengaluru vide letter at (3) above has sent proposal with the compliance report to Government of Karnataka with a request to accord Stage-II approval by Stipulating Certain Conditions.

The proposal has been examined in detail and hence the order.

## Government Order No. FEE 36 FLL 2021 Bengaluru, Dated: 28-10-2022

In the circumstances as explained in the preamble above, the Government is pleased to accord Stage-II approval for Diversion of 0.0978 hectare of forest land in Kurkunda Village, Sy. No. 202, Mallat Hobli, Manvi Taluk, Raichur District for construction of Main Balancing Tank, Approach Road (3.15 m width) and laying of 150 mm Dia Water Pipeline under Combined Water Supply Scheme to Mallat and 10 other Villages in Manvi Taluk of Raichur District in favour of the Executive Engineer, Rural Drinking Water Supply and Sanitation Department, Raichur subject to the fulfilment of following conditions:

- 1. The legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged and it shall continue to be Forest land.
- 2. The User agency shall pay the applicable Net Present Value (NPV), Compensatory Plantation cost of extraction of tress (if any), Land lease rent and any other levis as per the conditions of approval.
- 3. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Deputy Conservator of Forest Officer.
- 4. The Lessee shall not sub-lease mortgage & hypothecate the forest area.
- 5. The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the District Collector.
- 6. The pipeline shall be laid down 1.5 meter below the ground and after lying down of pipe line the ground will be levelled.
- 7. User Agency shall obtain Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
- 8. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 9. Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 10. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the project proposal.
- 11. The application for renewal of the lease hand over the lease, in the prescribed form and manner shall be submitted at least six months prior to the expiry of forest lease. In case no renewal is sought, the Lessee shall hand over the lease.
- 12. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of central Government.
- 13. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 14. The forest area shall be used for the purpose for which it is granted. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 0.0978 ha.

- 15. In case the land is not used for the stipulated purpose within two years or when it is no longer needed for the stipulated purpose, the area would stand resumed to the Forest Department.
- 16. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
- 17. The period of diversion under this approval shall be 20 Years or the project life, whichever is less.
- 18. No residential or commercial building shall be permitted in the forest area proposed for diversion.
- 19. No/crushing/breaking of stones or labour camp shall be allowed on forest land and all waste/debris generated shall be scientifically disposed off outside the forest area.
- 20. Any damage to forest area because of implementation of the proposal shall be compensated by the Lessee. The extent of damage shall be assessed by the jurisdiction Deputy Conservator of Forests/Conservator of Forests/Chief Conservator of Forests.
- 21. The Lessee shall ensure that no avoidable harm is caused to the fauna and flora in and around the proposed area.
- 22. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
- 23. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guideline F.No. 11-42/2017-FC dated: 29/01/2018.
- 24. The Forest Department and user agency shall comply the provisions of all the Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT order and Hon'ble Court order(s) pertaining to this project, if any for the time being in force as applicable to the project.
