7.	Background note on the proposal:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mahadeopuri underground coal mine is located at half a km from Parsia and about 26 km from Chhindwara. Vide letter No. 8-372/87-PC MoEF dated:- 11/10/1988 the forest clearance was granted for "Use of 865.82 ha, of Forest land for underground mining of coal and 1.832 ha of Forest Area for surface rights in Chhindwara district by WCL". The period of lease was 30 years. After this the Government of MP given the permission vide letter No. F/5/53/87/10/3 dated:- 13/01/1989. The letter (in Hindi) mentioned in Point no. 2 that "Lease period will be 30 years after the sanction of the lease". The lease agreement under Mineral Concession Rule 1960 was executed on 20th Aug 1993 and mining operations were started, after more than four year from the issue of permission by Government of MP & GoI. The User Agency continued the operations and after the receipt of the DFO letter dated:- 28/07/2023 it stopped mining operations. The proposal is for permission of grant of Mahadeopuri underground mining project and it has coal reserve which has been supplying Coal to Sarni thermal power plant. The reserve will be extracted through underground mining Method. The coal reserve is beneath forest land. This is an underground mining project and only 1.832 ha area to be used as surface rights. As per the project, there is no felling of trees in forest land.

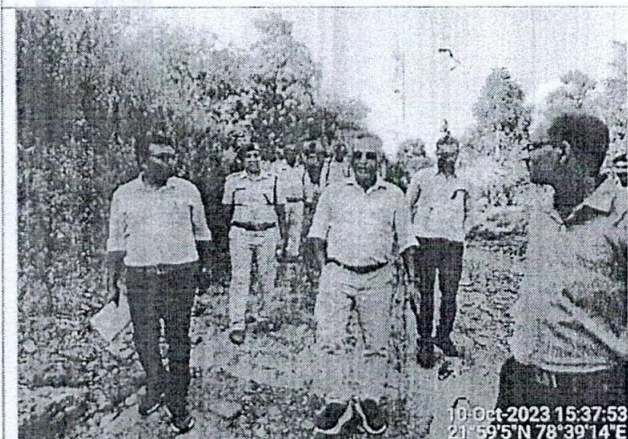

If yes, a detailed report on violation including action taken against the concerned officials:	As per the MoEF, New Delhi approval letter No. 8-372/87-PC dated 10.10.1988, the period of the lease is 30 years only. There after, the State Govt. of MP vide letter dated 03.01.1989 stated in point no 2, that <i>the period of lease will be 30 years after the handing over of forest land after obtaining valid mining lease</i> . The lease agreement under Mineral Concession Rule 1960 was executed on 20 th Aug 1993 and mining operations were started. So there was 4 year gap between the letter of permission of state government and starting of mining operations. The underground mining operations have been closed vide DFO West Chhindwara letter dated:- 28/07/2023. As per the FCA guidelines 2019, 7.6 <i>"The validity of clearance granted under FC of FC shall be coterminous with the life of the mine as per the approved mine plan subjected to a maximum of 30 years as provided in the MMDR Act 1957 as amended upto Mines and Minerals (development and regulation) amendment act 2015."</i>

The proposed area is divided into two categories :</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Underground mining area – 164.578 ha</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">Surface rights- 1.832 ha</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">Total - 166.41 ha</p> <p>The site inspection was conducted and it was informed by the User Agency that it has used only about 1.00 lha surface rights area and about 100 ha area was used for underground mining and rest of the area is yet to be mined out. As per the User Agency, till date only about 24 Lakh ton coal has been excavated and rest of the coal (about 17 Lakh Ton) will be extracted from remaining area in after obtaining approval. As per the MoEF, New Delhi approval letter dated 10.10.1988, the period of the lease is 30 years only. However, the State Govt. of MP letter dated 03.01.1989 stated that <i>the period of lease will be 30 years after the handing over of forest land after obtaining valid mining lease</i>. The User Agency obtained the mining lease four years after the grant of permission in 1993 and operated for 30 years until the letter from DFO Chhindwara West dated 28/07/2023.</p> <p>2. <u>Observation Regarding the Mining Plan</u></p> <p>The Ministry of Coal (GoI) has issued the guidelines for the preparation of Mining Plan for the Coal and lignite blocks vide letter no. F.No. 34011/28/2019-CPAM Dated- 16/12/2019. As per this guidelines “ <i>All coal (including Lignite) mining operations in India shall henceforth be governed as per these modified guidelines listed below and henceforth, the Mine Closure Plan and Final Mine Closure Plan shall be integral part of Mining Plan.</i>” There is also change in lease area (from 865.82 ha in previous phase to 166.41 ha in present proposal, so as per the said Guidelines 1.3, modification of Mining Plan is required. The User Agency has submitted the approved scheme dated:- 25/11/2019 but the Guidelines were issued by Ministry of Coal (GoI) dated – 16/12/2019. The clarification from the User Agency is needed in this regards.</p>



Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. 5153/87/10/3 dated 17.11.87 on the above mentioned subject seeking approval of the Central Government in accordance with section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and to say that the proposal has been examined by the Advisory Committee constituted by the Central Government under section 3 of the above said Act.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government and on the basis of the recommendation of the above mentioned committee, the Central Government hereby conveys its approval u/s 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for use of 865.82 Ha. of Forest land for Underground Mining and 1.832 Ha. of Forest land for surface rights in Chhindwara District by Western Coalfields Limited, subject to the following conditions -

- (1) The legal status of the forest land will remain unshaken.
- (2) Period of lease shall be 30 years
- (3) The area identified for compensation afforestation shall be declared NF/P and the necessary funds placed at the disposal of the Forest Department before handing over of the Forest area for mining.
- (4) No work over the surface will be done in the area asked for Underground Mining.
- (5) If and a later stage, it is found that the mining has resulted in damage to the Forests, the Company will have to provide equivalent non-forest area and cost of surface.
- (6) Mined over area shall be reclaimed/restored by the Company after mining is over.
- (7) In order that the construction labour and Staff while working on the project in the forest area may not cause destruction to forest area for meeting their fuel wood needs, the user agency will establish fuel wood depots, and will provide fuel wood or other energy source to them free of cost or its cost deducted from their salary and wages.
- (8) No explosive should be allowed to be stored in the forest area.
- (9) The conditions/safeguards proposed by the DOE will be strictly followed.

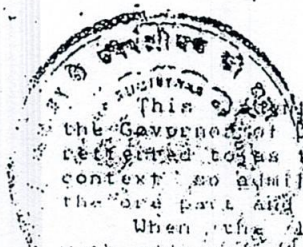




