Udaipur zone issues:

1. Presentation made by Mr. Rahul Bhatnagar, CCF(WL)Udaipur zone on the issues, progress and proposed new initiatives in Udaipur zone. He was accompanied with three DCF's - Mr.T Mohan Raj. DCF(WL)Jodhpur/ Mr. Kapil, DCF(WL) Rajsamand / Mr. Saini, DCF(WL) Chittorgarh .
2. Mr. Valmik Thapar raised issues related to the human settlement and encroachment in the protected areas of the Udaipur zone. He asked for a document with detailed maps on the encroachment in all PA's of the Udaipur zone. CCF(WL) Udaipur requested two months' times to prepare the document.
