Sub: Proposal for use of 0.48 ha (0.070 ha forest and 0.410 ha non-forest) from Son Ghariyal Wildlife Sanctuary for upgradation of Mayapur Khuteli Lauar road to Bichhari under Package No MP41209, Madhya Pradesh-FP/MP/ROAD/51020/2020.

Sir,

Reference is invited to the subject mentioned above. The above proposal was discussed in the 73rd Meeting of Standing Committee of National Board for Wild Life held on 17th July, 2023 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

2. After discussion, the Standing Committee decided to recommend the proposal subject to following conditions:

1. All the construction material will be brought from outside the sanctuary.
2. No construction be done after sunset and before sunrise.
3. The user agency or his contractor/labour shall not create any fire places in the protected area or use the firewood and bushes from the protected area.
4. The user agency/or its contractor shall be responsible for any contraventions of the provisions of the Forest Acts and Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 committed by its staff and labour inside the protected area.
5. The construction or any other waste generated during the execution of the project shall be disposed of outside the protected area.
6. Caution signboards (fluorescent/radium) about animal crossing as per the advice of the Forest Department should be provided by User Agency at appropriate places along the road.
7. The animal passage plan submitted along with the proposal shall be implemented by the User Agency in toto.
8. The annual compliance certificate on the stipulated conditions should be submitted by the project proponent to the State Chief Wild Life Warden and an annual compliance certificate shall be submitted by the State Chief Wild

Life Warden to the Government of India.
