Dear Sir,

Gujarat State Petronet Limited, (GSPL) Gandhinagar a Government of Gujarat undertaking, has been entrusted with responsibilities of erecting Gas Grid (Pipeline Network) for transportation of Natural Gas in the State of Gujarat.

As a part of project, GSPL has planned to lay 8" dia Natural gas pipeline to supply Natural Gas to Bhilosa Industries situated in Dadra & Nagar Haveli, District Dadra & Nagar Haveli. The start point of the pipeline is from our existing end point at Village:- Borlai, Taluka:- Umargam, District:- Valsad.

The total length of proposed pipeline is about 5.2 Km (Bhilosa Industries). The proposed pipeline will be laid at a depth of 1.2 Mtr. below ground level All safety precaution shall be measured as per OISD standard.

The proposed Natural pipeline along with an OFC will passing through Territorial Forest Division, Dadra & Nagar Haveli. We also propose to use only 01 (One) m of Right of Use (RoU) area as compared to 12 m for the rest of the pipeline route outside forest areas. It will be worthy to state here that the pipeline will be laid 1.2 m (approx.) below the natural ground level and land shall be restored back to its normal position after laying the pipeline.

The details of area required for diversion of forest land for laying this pipeline is furnished below: -
