Sub: (R&B) Dept – Diversion of 8.50 Ha forest land in Jayashankar Bhupalapally District- “Widening from Single lane to Double lane of Khammampally - Bhupalapally road from km 1/100 to 20/600 in Jayashankar Bhupalapally district”. – Submission of Proposals-reg.

With reference cited, the work “Widening from Single lane to Double lane of Khammampally - Bhupalapally road from km 1/100 to 20/600 in Jayashankar Bhupalapally district” is sanctioned to an amount of 2900.00 lakhs. It is an important road in Jayashankar bhupalapally.

This road is the shortest route to reach district hqrs and almost reduces about 35 km distance to reach district hqrs and also shortest route to reach the coal belt areas of Manthini, Godavarikhani in Pedda pally district and Bhupalpally in Jayashankhar District further connects KTPP at Chelpur in Jayashankhar District . Improvement of this road helps in industrial growth in Pedda pally district and Jayashankhar District and also helps in carrying agricultural goods to the nearby marketing centers. This road also connects many interior villages like Peddathundla, Chinnathundla, Shathrajupally, Kishanraopally to District head quarter Bhupalapally for their education, medical aid and for daily needs.

In view of the above the widening of the road is proposed to improve the connectivity and convenience to the vehicular traffic. The road length 7.056 km is passing through the Tadicherla reserve Forest. The above forest reach is under the forest Jurisdiction of Bhupalapally Forest Division. It is proposed to take up road widening from single lane to Double Lane, as such the permissions of the forest authorities is required. Hence proposal is submitted for diversion of forest land to an extent of 8.50Ha in Bhupalapally Division.

The DGPS survey is carried out in the above reach. As per our requirement the total extent of forest land is arrived as 8.50 Ha in Jurisdiction of Bhupalapally forest Division, for which diversion of the Forest Land is required. The raw data of alignment (1 CD) is already submitted to the PCCF for authentication.

The proposals are being submitted as per the guidelines issued under Forest (Conservation) Act 1980, the project for road construction will be processed in their entirety. Hence, the proposals for diversion of forest land is prepared in the prescribed format.


Hence, I herewith submit the proposals under Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 with the following enclosures. It is , therefore, requested to arrange to initiate the process for diversion of forest land and also required to pass necessary orders to the concerned to start the field survey as

early as possible for submitting same to the Government for according approval of diversion of forest land in reserve forest.

The ROFR certificate issued by the District Collector along with the enclosures shall be obtained and furnished to the DFO, Bhupalapally, for processing.
