विषय: Diversion of 0.97 Ha of Reserved Forest Land for sea front road development at Jampore Beach in the Union Territory of Daman.

Madam/Sir,

This refers to letter No. DCF/FCA/DMN/01/2016-17/20 dated 17.11.2017 of the CCF & Nodal Officer (FCA), UT Govt. of Dadra Nagar Haveli & Daman Diu on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change under section 2 of Van (Sanrakshan Evamm Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980. After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government, the 'In-Principle/Stage-I' approval of the Central Government for the diversion of the said forest land was accorded vide letter No. 6-DNB050/2017-BHO/1047 dated 22.01.2018 subject to fulfillment of certain conditions. The UT Government vide its letter No. EE/PWD/WD-I/DMN/TB/2024-25/1555 dated 21.02.2025 have furnished compliance report online (after lapse of validity of IPA) in respect of the relevant conditions stipulated in the In-principle approval for grant of final approval.

The Compliance Report was duly examined by the Central Government and it has been observed that the compliance is not complete and request for extension of validity of IPA is not sought. Thus, the Union Territory Government is requested to submit the following information/ documents for further processing:

1. In the compliance of condition No. 17, Boundary of diverted forest land shall be demarcated on ground at project cost as per direction of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer, status of the same is not furnished and the same shall be submitted.
2. In the compliance of various general conditions, it is mentioned that "User Agency Agreed". In this regard, UT Government is requested to provide undertaking of User Agency separately for each of the conditions.
3. The non-forest land provided for Compensatory Afforestation shall be transfer and mutated in favour of Forest Department and the land shall be notified as RF/PF under relevant rules and guidelines. Status in this respect is not

clearly furnished.

4. Stage-I approval was issued on 22.01.2018, compliance report received after more than 07 years (after lapse of validity of IPA). In this regard, Union Territory Administration is requested to submit following clarifications/information:
 - a. UT administration is requested to provide reason for such delay in submission of compliance report.
 - b. Status of working permission and work done by the User Agency, if any.
 - c. Amount of NPV shall be collected from the User Agency as per revised rates of NPV. Status in this regard is to be furnished.
 - d. The UT Administration shall also seek extension of validity of In-principle approval.

In view of above, I am directed to request the UT administration to submit the above information at the earliest please.
