I submit that the report called for in the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests letter 1st cited has been received from the District Forest Officer, Theni vide reference 2nd cited. The District Forest Officer, Theni has reported that the proposed project location of Check Dam across Sambalar river is not falling in the Eco Sensitive Zone of Megamalai Wildlife Sanctuary and Kodaikanal Wildlife Sanctuary. The distance between the proposed project site and boundary of Megamalai Wildlife Sanctuary Eco Sensitive Zone is 35.91Km and Kodaikanal Wildlife Sanctuary is 4.22Km.

As per the DSS mapping of Tiger corridors available in www.ntca.gov.in the proposed project site falls within the Tiger corridor. The corridor is between the Mathikettan Shola National Park and Pambadum Shola National Park of Kerala state. Further the District Forest Officer, Theni has stated that the proposed project is essential activity as it is intending to provide drinking water to Bodi Municipality and will not be a hindrance to movement of wildlife.

I submit that the District forest Officer, Theni has been instructed to inform the user agency for getting the clearance of the National Board of Wildlife for obtaining prior approval under Forest (Conservation) Act.1980 for this project. The report of the District Forest Officer, Theni may be accepted and the project proposal under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 may be considered on receipt of prior clearance of National Board of Wildlife.
