

Sub.: Diversion of 13.1959 ha of Protected Forest land in Survey No. PF-112 of forest range, Sirmour in Rewa Division for construction of Hydro Power Project in favour of Manager, Marshal Small Hydro Power Private Limited, in Rewa District of Madhya Pradesh.

With reference to the above mentioned subject and letter under referenced I am directed to inform you that the proposal was examined in MoEF&CC, New Delhi level and it is observed that the proposal needs further clarifications. Observations of MoEF&CC, New Delhi is as follows:

- Power generation projects generate huge amount of muck due to tunneling etc. and safe disposal of muck is one of the prime concern to prevent environmental hazards like siltation of water bodies, choking of drainage lines etc. Also, the map submitted clearly delineates an area earmarked for muck disposal.
- Muck disposal is a non site specific land use and the same may be shifted to nearby non forest land. In case of non availability of non forest land, it is to be ensured that minimum forest land is proposed for diversion for safe disposal of generated muck.

In view of the above observation, I am directed to request you to kindly clarify the above facts and submit the proper muck disposal plan.
