Report of the site inspection undertaken by Shri Ravinder Singh, Technical Officer (Forestry) Grade-I. Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Northern Regional Office, Chandigarh on 27th November, 2019 on the complaint made by Shri PP Kapoor, Panipat regarding environmental degradation by cutting about 15000 trees by the PWD (B&R) Panipat during construction of proposed widening of Sector 18 road (from GT road to Barsat road pool) under Forest Division and District Panipat, Haryana: reg.

It is pertinent to mention here that a complaint has been received in the Union Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, New Delhi from Shri PP Kapoor, RTI Activist, near Bansal Foundry, Samalkha, District Panipat, Haryana in which he has alleged that the PWD (B&R) Panipat is planning to cut 15,000 green trees in the name of widening of Sector-18 road (from GT road to Barsat road pool) under Forest Division and District Panipat, Haryana.

- Acting upon the above mentioned complaint of Shri PP Kapoor, Union Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, New Delhi has directed this office to investigate the above mentioned matter and report the Ministry accordingly.
- In compliance to the directions of the Union Ministry, undersigned was directed by the Dy. DGF(C) to carry out the site inspection of the proposed road widening of Sector 18 (from GT road to Barsat road pool) under Forest Division and District Panipat, Haryana.
- Pursuant to the instructions of the Dy. DGF (C), undersigned reached the site on 27th November, 2019 at 10.30 A.M. where DCF Panipat with her field staff, User Agency, i.e., PWD (B&R) Panipat, Irrigation Department Panipat and Complainant were also present. At the outset, undersigned explained about the purpose of the proposed site visit and discussed other facts in detail with Team at the site, which comprises the following members:

- on the site DCF, Panipat was requested to explain the facts of the complain. She explained that till date no proposal for diversion of forest land for construction of proposed road has been received in the forest depertment. The area in question is protected forest and ownership of the said land is with brigation Department, Panipat. Neither any construction work nor any tree cutting has been done on the proposed site. The DCF, Panipat further explained that as per enumeration list there are only 2,005 trees including 1,250 plants instead of 15,000 green trees as alleged by the complainant.
- BDO, PWD, B&R, Panipat explained that acting upon the public announcement No. 22690 dated 20th August, 2018 of Hon'ble CM Haryana, on the request of Irrigation Department, PWD, B&R has prepared the proposal for construction of Sector 18 road (from GT road to Barsat road pool) under Forest Division and District Panipat, Haryana. The project is being prepared for seeking prior approval of Government of India under FCA,1980 and still pending with PWD (B&R), Panipat (In question why the adjoining 100 feet road is not being used instead of construction of the proposed 30 feet road, he explained that the 100 feet road has been prepared by the HUDA and they refused to use this road for general public as the same has been proposed.

7. ALLEGATIONS OF THE COMPLAINANT:

The PWD (Black), Panipat and Irrigation Department have prepared a project proposal for construction of Sector 18 road (from GT road to Barsat road pool) under Forest Division and District Panipat, Haryana in which 15,000 green trees will be axed whereas 100 feet wide alternate parallel road is available.

8. ACTUAL POSITION ON THE GROUND;

The area in question is under the ownership of Irrigation Department which has been declared as protected forest area. Total 2,005 trees including 1,250 plants are standing over the proposed site instead of 15,000 green trees alleged by the complainant. Neither any tree/plant have been felled nor any forest area have been found damaged on the site. Alternate parallel road of 100 feet wide is also available just about 90 mtrs away from the proposed site. As per the DCF, Panipat, no project proposal has been received by the Forest Department, Panipat under FCA, 1980 for widening of the said road.

O. FINDING IN THE INQUIRY

The complaint made by Shri PP Kapoor, RTI Activist, Samalkha, District Panipat, Haryana has been discussed in details with team comprises

DCF Panipat with her field staff, User Agency, i.e., PWD (B&R) Panipat, Irrigation Department Panipat, owner of the land in question and Complainant. After detailed celebration on each and every possible aspects to save the trees as well as forest area, joint inspection was carried out on 27th November, 2019. Following are the observations:

- (i) The area in question is under the ownership of Irrigation Department which has been declared as protected forest and 2,005 trees including 1,250 plants are standing over it.
- (ii) As alternate parallel road of 100 feet wide is also available just about 90 mtrs away from the proposed site and no project proposal has been received by the Forest Department, Panipat under FCA, 1980 for widening of the said road, hence, the question for widening of proposed Sector 18 road (from GT road to Barsat road) pool) over the protected forest area is does not arise.
- (iii)11, in the future, the proposed proposal for widening of Sector-18 road (froin GT road to Barsat road pool) over the protected forest area is received by the forest department for prior approval of Government of India under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, the same will not be considered for approval because the alternate road is available in this case.
