3) A copy of the Government letter in reference 5th cited is also enclosed for reference.



With reference to the subject and reference, I am directed to request to furnish the following information / documents / rectification etc at the earliest for further processing of the subject proposal;

- Correct Kml file of the forest area proposed for diversion may be furnished and the same shall be uploaded along with the online application in the PARIVESH Web Portal;
- The DFO, Dindigul Forest Division has reported that no rare/ endangered / unique species of flora and fauna are found in the area and also no threat to major wildlife species. However, the DFO in Part II of the online application reported that fauna like Bison, Fox, Wild boar, Hare, Porcupine are present in and around the forest land proposed for diversion. Hence, may clarify whether any Schedule I wild animals are present in the forest area proposed for diversion, if so, may kindly prepare wildlife mitigation plan and same may be submitted to this office along with the comments of the Chief Wildlife Warden regarding impact of the road proposal on wildlife and its habitat.
