I am directed to refer to your letter No. FP/UK/MIN/46859/2020 dated 01.9.2020 regarding above mentioned subject for seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and to inform that scrutiny of the said proposal in the Ministry revealed certain information lacking in the proposal and accordingly it is requested to furnish the following additional information from the State Government for further action:

- (i) Undertaking to bear the cost of Compensatory Afforestation.
- (ii) Undertaking for non use of the heavy machinery for the mining.
- (iii) undertaking for no work during monsoon season.
- (iv) As per the DSS, it is found that the project site is falling within 10 Km range of the Eco- Sensitive Zone of the Rajaji National Park, therefore, the status regarding approval of Wildlife Clearance may be informed accordingly.
- (v) As per the DSS analysis, out of 190.0 ha proposed forest land about 1 ha is VDF and 31.0 ha is MDF.
- (vi) A certificate conveying that no plantation/afforestation has been taken up in the past under any scheme/plan in the proposed sites for CA.
