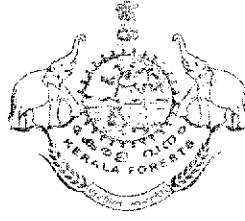

Chedleth Range.



6. Remaining areas are water logging areas including paddy fields. Planting in these areas may not be ecologically viable. I am herewith enclosing Compensatory Afforestation Site Suitability Certificate. Balance planting can be done in felled Teak plantations also under CA scheme. 1959 Kurichipatta Bit I can also be planted under CA where the effective planting area is 10.6 Hectare.
