Proposal for diversion of 7.448 ha Reserved forest land for construction of new coal transportation road from Jayant to Morwa railway siding in favour of General Manager, Jayant Project NCL in Singrouli District in Madhya Pradesh (6-MPC018/2019-BHO).

General Description:

The Legal status of the forest land proposed for diversion is Reserved Forest.

Maps of the site are submitted. 2)

The item-wise break-up of to the forest land proposed for diversion Area (Ha) Village Survey No. Forest Division No. Purpose wise breakup RF - 278 1.673 Construction of new coal transportation road Singrouli Medhauli RF - 274 5.774

In addition to the above forest land, no non-forest land is required for the project.

The estimated cost of the project is Rs. 2019 Lakh and manpower to be generated, Permanent-00 & Temporary- 400 person.

Cost-benefit analysis is submitted Density of vegetation is 0.2 to 0.3 and 1,151 trees are marked for felling on the proposed forest

land. A 906 number of trees upto 60 cm. Species-wise & girth-wise details is submitted. It has been certified that the requirement of proposed forest land is unavoidable & barest minimum. 1) In addition to the above forest land, no non-forest land is required for the project.

5) The estimated cost of the project is Rs. 8500 Lakh and manpower to be generated, Permanent- 150 & Temporary- 25 person.

6) Cost-benefit analysis has been submitted.

7) Density of vegetation is 0.1 and 885 trees are marked for felling on the proposed forest land. A 336 number of trees upto 60 cm. Species-wise & girth-wise details have been made available.

8) It has been certified that the requirement of proposed forest land is unavoidable & barest minimum. Details regarding exploration of alternatives and the suitability of present alternative have been given on a map & comparative analysis not submitted.

9) There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act., 1980.

The proposed forest land does not form any part of National Park/Wildlife Sanctuary/Biosphere Reserve/Tiger Reserve/Elephant Corridor etc. and proposed project is 0.015 km away from the Balaram-Ambaji Wildlife Sanctuary.

11) A 1.908 ha land in Balaram-Ambaji Sanctuary for construction of Ambaji Bye Pass Road Km 0/0 to 4/256 (Length 4.526 km width 45 mtr around Ambaji Towunship has recommended by Chief Wildlife Warden is submitted.

There is no protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument located in the proposed area.

13) Environmental Clearance is not required under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for this project.

14) Displacement of people is and rehabilitation plan is not applicable.

15) CCF (T), Nodal Officer and State Government have recommended the proposal for approval.

As per GMDC letter dated 15/06/2018 has mentioned that metal mining lease over an area of 184,9840 ha at Village-Ambaji & Jarivav of Banaskantha District is holding and GMDC has no objection, if Road & Building department, after considering the technical, economical & social aspects divert the proposed bye-pass as per alignment shown in enclosed plan.

Observations of Regional Office:

a. The proposal is in two parts i.e 13.278 ha RF for diversion and 9.90 ha re-diversion

b. The 9.90 ha re-diversion, the a chunk of forest land was given to GMDC for mining and out of which for 9.90 ha forest land GMDC had given NOC to R&B Department, Govt. of Gujarat for road construction.

c. The status of the forest clearance give to GMDC is not submitted.

d. There is standard condition in all the cases "The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government". Thus required changes needs to approved form the Govt. of India.

e. The proposal attracts Para 1.2 (iv) of FCA Handbook 2019: Violation on account of change of land use in the approved mining plan.

f. Details regarding exploration of alternatives and the suitability of present alternative have been given on a map & comparative analysis not submitted/uploaded.

The CWLW letter dt. 30/03/2016 is for 1.908 ha out of 23.178 ha, however, detailed break out the project in the Protected area, eco-sensitive zone area and outside protected area long with detailed CWLW comments for eco-sensitive zone shall be submitted.

h. The CA scheme of Model No 3 with 1111/ ha on non-forest land is submitted which is not in accordance to the Para 2.8 (iii) of FCA Handbook 2019. Thus, site specific CA scheme as per the Para 2.8 (iii) of FCA Handbook 2019 is required.

Recommendations of REC:

The REC examined the proposal for diversion of forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The REC also saw the proposal on the Decision Support System (DSS) of FSI.

Accordingly, REC defers the proposal for diversion for 25.178 ha (13.278 ha RF + 9.90 ha Rediversion) Section-4 & Reserved Forest land for construction of Ambaji bypass road Km. 0/00 to Km. 51/150 on Himmatnagar- Kheroj-Ambaji-Abu road SH-9 in favour of Executive Engineer, R&B Division (State) in Banaskanatha District of Gujarat for want of following informations:

 The proposal is in two parts i.e 13.278 ha RF for diversion and 9.90 ha re-diversion, thus the status of the forest clearance given to GMDC and copy of Stage-II approval shall be submitted.

The CWLW letter dt. 30/03/2016 is for 1.908 ha out of 23.178 ha, however, detailed break up
of the project in the protected area, eco-sensitive zone area and outside protected area long with
detailed CWLW comments for eco-sensitive zone shall be submitted.

5. The proposal attracts Para 5.6 (b) "In case the re-diversion of a forest land becomes necessary for another purpose by another user agency a fresh proposal for prior approval under FCA has to be sent to GOI.". Thus, the separate proposal 13.278 ha RF for diversion and 9.90 ha re-diversion shall be submitted for consideration.

6. As the GMDC project was approved form the MoEFCC, New Delhi, thus the 9.90 ha rediversion proposal shall be submitted to MoEFCC for approval.

Accordingly, REC in-principle approves the proposal for diversion for 24.695 ha Reserved forest land for laying of 400 KV Double Circuit Vindhyachal/Sasan-Rewa Transmission line for THDC Coal Mines in favour of Chief Manager, Power Grid Corporation of India Limited in Singrouli District in Madhya Pradesh for Stage-I approval on standard terms and condition

However, the Stage-I approval shall be issued only after receipt of following information:

1. The CA is proposed over two patches (1) 60 ha at PF 776 effective CA area 40 ha and (2) 32 ha at PF 777 totalling to effective CA area 40 + 32 = 72 ha. As per DSS analysis, the CA shows 24 ha MDF out of 60 ha and 4 ha MDFo out of 32 ha. However, the 60 ha at PF 776 is not acceptable and revised CA patch of 40 ha on degraded forest land (CD > 0.4) shall be submitted.

2. The revised CA scheme for selected patch as per Sl. No. (1) shall be submitted & uploaded on e.porta.
