4 Lane Widening of Jhansi Babina Lalitpur NH-26 km.Hansari to Khailar Border Km. 3. To km.11

The details of the proposals are as under:

1. The proposal was submitted vide No. P-1951/81-2-2019-800(64)/2019 dated from Special Secretary Department of Forest, Govt. of UP. It has been signed and recommended by the all concerned authorities in the part I, II, III, IV & V. No specific comments have been made in Part II, III, IV and V regarding the proposal and recommendation has been made emphasising the vital importance of the proposal. There is no alternative route other than passing through the proposed forest area. The project is necessary in large public interest.

1. As per the Site inspection reports on page-no. 35 of Proposal filled by the concerned DCF having territorial jurisdiction on proposed forest patches, **violation of Forests (Conservation) Act-1980 has been reported** (Site inspection report at page no. 35).
2. As per part II of the proposal the proposed forest patch is not part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Reserve, Wildlife Migration Corridor etc. and does not fall within eco sensitive zone of the protected area.
3. As per part II of the proposal; the proposed forest patches are not located in the area having protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument and no any rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the area.
4. The proposal involves felling of (850 trees and 95 poles) total 945 trees in number.
5. The detail of forest area and number of trees (girth class >30 cm) is as under-

6. The certificate of District Magistrate under Forests (Rights) Act 2006 is placed with the proposal on pages no 41-44 of proposal.
7. As per GIS-DSS analysis, proposed forest land for diversion and CA land have passed the GIS-DSS analysis (on page no.4-1/c).
8. The total outlay of the proposal is Rs Rs.5554.77 lakh.
9. The details of employment generation through the proposal are 25000 man-days.

A letter no. **8B/UP/06/86/2018/FC/361** dated **17.10.2019** was issued to the **Special Secretary State Government of Uttar Pradesh** for EDS and the reply is submitted vide their letter No. **2946/81-2-2019-800 (64)2019** dated **17.12.2019** as detailed below:

- (A) A Proposal of a Lane widening of NH-25 Jhansi-lalitpur road - Babina road km 0 to 11.00 & felling of 1800 trees was submitted earlier vide online proposal no. 24768/2017 involving 20.35 ha. of Forest land. Now the fresh proposal submitted by the State Government vide online proposal no. 39827/2019 relates of 4 lane widening of same road from km. to 11.00 involving 14.8 ha. & felling of 945 Trees. It is not clarified whether the earlier proposal stands withdrawn by the State Government or not?

Reply: The query raised in Sr. No. 01 of EDS has been resolved and corrected. The revised proposal for 14.8ha has been submitted and proposal for 20.35 ha. submitted earlier wherein defence land was included has been withdrawn by the State Govt.

- B. It is also not clarified :-

(i) Why the original proposal has been modified or why a new proposal has been submitted.

Reply : In total length of the Road was 11 km wherein 3 km. Of Defence was included now a fresh proposal excluding 3 km stretch of defence land has been proposed.

(ii) What will be the outcome if NOC of ministry of Defence is not obtained/issued and what is the alternative available for the user agency to complete the project and how does it affect the viability of the project.

Reply : In case the NOC is not provided by the defence the width of median shall be reduced .

- C. The Forest offence has been compounded after taking compensation but calculation of Penal NPV payable as per recent guidelines of the Ministry dated 29.01.2019 is not correct as not been calculated for each year of violation. This needs rectification.

D.

Reply : The query raised in Sr. No. (C) of EDS has been resolved and a revised calculation for Penal NPV has been given.

E. In Area calculation sheet, uniform width of proposed widening has been taken. It is not clear whether extra width is required at culverts, bridges etc. And to what extent requirement of Forest area increase in that case.

Reply : Cross section map is attached. Additional width not required, extra culvert Bridge shall not be constructed.

Decision of REC:

1. User Agency was not able to make presentation regarding the project and could not answer to the queries made by the REC members.
2. Also the tabulated sheet detailing the Existing ROW, Proposed ROW and balance width available for road side plantation is not available in the proposal and could not be either explained by the User Agency.

Hence REC deferred the proposal.
