उपरोक्त विषय का आशय ग्रहण करने का कष्ट करें। विषयवस्तु प्रकरण में राज्य सरकार द्वारा वन (संरक्षण) अधिनियम, 1980 की धारा (2) के अन्तर्गत भारत सरकार की स्वीकृति मांगी है।

उक्त प्रकरण को दिनांक- 28.12.2017 को आहूत की गयी क्षेत्रीय सशक्त समिति (REC) की बैठक में सम्मिलित किया गया था। क्षेत्रीय सशक्त समिति की बैठक (REC) दिनांक- 28.12.2017 की कार्यवाही की प्रति (REC Agenda item 23.12 -U.P.) संलग्न है।

8/DP/06/53/2017/FC: Frost Land proposed to be Diverted for from 2 Laning to 4 Laning ON (SH-18) Road widening and Strengthening from Jarif nagar Durgpur to Ujhani from Ch. 162.000 Km to 207.400 Km on Meerut - Budaun Road in Budaun District.

The details of the proposals are as under:

1. The proposal has been signed and recommended by the all concerned authorities in the part I, II, III, IV & V. No specific comments have been made in Part II, III, IV and V regarding the proposal and the proposal has been recommended.
2. As per Site inspection reports of DFO & DFO (on page 16 and 56 of the proposal) and Part II of the proposal filled by the concerned DFOs having territorial jurisdiction on proposed forest patches- no violation of Forests (Conservation) Act-1980 has been reported.
3. As per part II of the proposal the proposed forest patch is not part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Reserve, Wildlife Migration Corridor etc. and the proposed forest land does not fall within eco sensitive zone of the protected area.
4. As per part II of the proposal; the proposed forest patches are not located in the area having protected archaeological / heritage site / defence establishment or any other important monument.
5. The detail of forest area and number of trees (girth class >30 cm) and poles/plants (girth class< 30cm) is as under:

Remarks: The State Government vide letter no. 2971/14-2-2017-800(59)/2017 dated 20.12.2017 seeks selling permission of 10,647 no. of trees only. The forwarding letter needs revision as per information provided in proposal.

6. As per part II of the proposal all patches belong to forest type Eco Class III and vegetation density is 0.4.
7. Compensatory Afforestation has been proposed on double degraded forest land i.e. 54.6022= 129.20 ha. in fourteen patches. As per the GIS- DSS analysis, the proposed compensatory afforestation patch is suitable for plantation and having adequate extent.

8. The certificate of District Magistrate under Forests (Rights) Act 2006 is placed with the proposal on pages 4.
9. The Total outlay of the proposal is Rs. 31678.13 Lakhs.
10. The details of the employment generation potential of the proposal are permanent NIL and temp. 1,00,000 man days.
11. The user agency has submitted undertaking to make payments of Net Present Value (NPV), Compensatory Afforestation (CA) etc. Details of CA & NPV levies are mentioned below in a tabular form:

The proposal was submitted vide letter no. F-69/14-2-2017-800(59)/2017 dated 01st August 2017 and an EDS was raised due to few shortcomings of the proposal vide letter no. SB/UP/06/53/2017/FC/78 dated 16th August 2017. The reply of EDS is still awaited. The issues raised in EDS are mentioned below:

1. The proposal is a continuation of proposal submitted online FP/UP/ROAD/23576/2017 for widening of the same SH 18 and as per provisions contained in 2.2 (iii) of FCA Handbook integrated proposal shall be submitted not in piecemeal. The matter needs clarification.
2. The signature of person authorised to make application on behalf of User Agency has not been authenticated at part I A-3(xvii).
3. Geo referenced map uploaded at C-b (vi) in part I of the proposal is without geo coordinates of key points.
4. Benefit Cost Analysis provided at Gii(a) in part I is incorrect.

- regarding position of RoW on both sides of the centre line of the road, position of proposed widening on both sides and balance protected forest width.
- (b) Difference in chainage length and net length has not been explained in the proposal.
6. Linear Strip plan uploaded with the proposal does not provide details of RoW, widening width required and balance width remaining.
 7. (a) As per GIS DSS analysis area of proposed compensatory afforestation is 119 ha only whereas as per requirement of afforestation on double degraded forest land it should be $2 \times 64.6 = 129.2$ ha. The issue needs rectification.
 - (b) CA estimates are without incorporating cost escalation due to inflation.
 - (c) CA has been proposed on 12 patches, all located in flood plains & river bed of Ganga, the site suitability of such CA patches need reassessment on grounds of survival of plantations during floods.
 8. NPV calculation uploaded online is based on incorrect rates.
 9. Site inspection report of CIF (as the extent of diversion > 40 ha) is not in prescribed format.
 10. Part V of the proposal has not been uploaded with the part II online.
 11. District Magistrate has counter signed the certificate to be issued under FRA 2006. The certificate is without date and dispatch no. The content of certificate shall incorporate issues related to rights of primitive forest dwelling communities along with scheduled Tribe population.
 12. Various certificates/documents regarding Van Swaroop Land, non involvement of ESZ of PAs etc has not been uploaded with the proposal.

The compliance of proposal has been submitted from Special Secretary, Government of UP vide letter no. 2971/14-2-2017-800(59)/2017 dated 20th December 2017. The issues on sl. No. 04, 08 and 11 of EDS have not been resolved as yet. Further, the felling permission for 10647 no. of trees sought by State Government vide letter dated 20th December 2017 is in variance with the information provided in hard copy of proposal (14,875 no. of poles + 11256 no. of trees).

Decision of REC-

REC deferred the proposal with a observation that replies of EDS shall be furnished on or before next REC.
