Online Proposal No: FP/UP/ROAD/22835/2016

SB/UP/06/22/2017/FC: Forest land proposed to be diverted for widening and strengthening of Chibramau-Saurikh-Bidhuna (MDR 13) in Kannauj District, (Proposed forest land diversion is having extent 21.6 ha with felling of 1,554 no of trees)

The details of the proposals are as under:

1. The proposal has been signed and recommended by the all concerned authorities in the part I, II, III, IV & V. In part II, III, IV and V of the proposal no specific comments have been recorded by the concerned authorities.
2. As per Site inspection report (page 13 of the proposal) and Part II filled by the concerned DFO having territorial jurisdiction on proposed forest patches: violation of Forests (Conservation) Act-1980 has not been reported.
3. As per part II of the proposal the proposed forest patches for diversion are not part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Reserve, Wildlife Migration Corridor etc. And the proposed forest land does not fall within eco sensitive zone of any protected area.
4. As per part II of the proposal; the proposed forest patches are not located in the area having protected archaeological heritage site / defence establishment or any other important monument.
5. The detail of forest area and number of trees (girth class >30 cm) is as under:-

6. As per part II of the proposal all patches belong to forest type Eco Class III and vegetation density is 0.4.
7. Compensatory Afforestation has been proposed on double degraded forest land i.e. $21.6 \times 2 = 43.20$ or 43.20 ha. on five patches having location in Adampur, Gopalpur and Kausia Forest Block of Kannauj Range of Forest Division, Kannauj. As per the GIS- DSS analysis, the proposed compensatory afforestation patches are suitable for plantation and having extent >43.20 ha.
8. The certificate of District Magistrate under Forests (Rights) Act 2006 is placed with the proposal on page 21.
9. The estimated cost of the project is Rs 2492.49 lakhs.
10. The detail of the employment generation potential of the proposal is permanent- 60 nos and temporary-25,000 man days.
11. The user agency has submitted undertaking to make payments of Net Present Value (NPV), Compensatory Afforestation (CA), etc. Details of CA-% NPV levies are mentioned below in a tabular form.

The proposal was submitted vide letter no. P-18/14-2-2017-800(12)/2016 dated 10th March 2017 and an EDS was raised due to various shortcomings of the proposal vide letter no. SB/UP/06/22/2017/FC/597 dated 29th March 2017. The response of EDS has been submitted vide letter no. 1202/14-2-2017-800(12)/2016 dated 19th June 2017. The reply of EDS has following shortcomings which has been communicated vide letter no. SB/UP/06/22/2017/FC/148 dated 14th July 2017:

1. The kml file of diverted forest land has not been provided in CD. The uploaded kml file shows a shift and does not exactly show the proposed forestland. The same needs revision.
2. The uploaded top sheet showing proposed forest land for diversion is incomplete and proposed forest land is shown beyond the boundaries of top sheet.
3. Land schedule uploaded as additional document of part I is without details of balance of ROW or forest land after resubmitting for proposed forest land for diversion.
4. The benefit cost analysis enclosed with the proposal is not as per PCA guidelines and needs revision.

Decision of REC held on 26th July 2017 -

Regional Empowered Committee (REC) deferred the proposal due to non submission of proposal online on www.forestclearance.nic.in and non submission of reply.

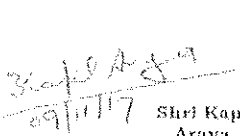
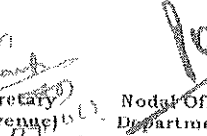
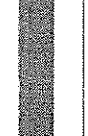
FEC decision was conveyed vide letter no. SB/UP/06/22/2017/FC/184 dated 28th July 2017. Incomplete compliances were submitted through different letter no. 204/11C-Kannauj/FP/UP/22835/2016 dated 28th July 2017, 639/11C-Kannauj/FP/UP/22835/2016 dated 4th September 2017 from CCF cum Nodal Officer, FCA, Department of Forests, Government of UP and letter no.2000/14-2-2017-800(12)/2017 dated 28th September 2017 from Special Secretary, Department of Forest, Government of UP. Regional Office has communicated shortcomings through even number dated 16th August 2017, 28th September 2017 and 24th October 2017. The reply of last EDS is still awaited from State Government. The proposal has following shortcomings:

1. Revised land schedule does not provide details of balance of width of RoW remaining on both RHS & LHS.
2. Benefit cost analysis as per MoEF & CC guidelines.

Decision of REC-

The proposal was deferred due to non submission of compliance.
