Sub: Diversion of 19.927 ha. forest land in favour of Public Works Division, Allapalli for Link Road (MH-1057) Improvement/Upgradation and maintenance of Kasansur Ghotsur Gundram Bhumkam Road (ODR-16) including 2 major bridge at chainage 2+320 & chainage 5+010 in Taluka- Etapalli, District- Gadchiroli in the State of Maharashtra-regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to State Government of Maharashtra's letter No. FLD-2021/C.R.176/F-10 dated 25.09.2021 and APCCF & Nodal Officer (FCA), Maharashtra letter No. Desk-17/NODAL/Gadchiroli/ID-12856/1034/21-22 dated 22.09.2021 on the above subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and to inform that the instant proposal was placed before Regional Empowered Committee in its meeting held on 26.10.2021. After detailed discussion and examination of the proposal and recommendation of State Government the Committee decided that proposal shall again placed before the REC after the receipt of following information:

- i. Compensatory Afforestation has been proposed over 39.854 ha. Degraded Forest Land (i) 17.00 ha. in Compt. No. 851 in Village- Gaul, Taluka- Pusad, District- Yavatmal (ii) 22.854 ha. in Compt. No. 435 in Village- Nandgvhan, Taluka- Mahagaon, District- Yavatmal. Since CA land is proposed over degraded forest land twice in extent outside Gadchiroli, CA over equivalent Non-Forest Land needs to be proposed. If CA is proposed over Degraded Forest Land twice in extent, then CA needs to be proposed in Gadchiroli District only. Accordingly revised CA details, viz, CA Schemes, site suitability certificates, DGPS maps and KML files for all CA areas need to be submitted.
- ii. Details of Compensatory Afforestation viz. CA scheme has not been uploaded in Parivesh portal. Further, CA details viz. Differential GPS map of CA land, site specific CA scheme, site suitability certificate is not submitted along with the proposal. Necessary corrections shall be made in Parivesh portal and requisite documents shall be submitted.
- iii. The road is proposed in Biodiversity rich dense forest; accordingly specific comments of the PCCF, Wildlife regarding any possible adverse impact and mitigation measures thereof with respect to all proposed roads shall be obtained.
- iv. The number of project affected trees need to be revisited by keeping trees on outer RoW intact.
- v. Specific recommendation of PCCF (HoFF), Maharashtra is not submitted along with the proposal, the same needs to be submitted by the State Government.

- vi. Name of signing authority and date of submission is not mentioned in Part-I of Form-A submitted by User Agency along with the proposal. Revised copy of the same shall be submitted.
- vii. The State Government has mentioned in its covering letter that there are 1635 project affected trees, however, in online Part-II it is mentioned that 1634 nos. of trees. Exact number of trees shall be submitted.
- viii. KML file of CA land has been wrongly uploaded in Parivesh portal. Instead of KML file of CA land, KML file of proposed area has been uploaded. Necessary correction shall be made and intimated to this office.
- ix. Information on progress in CA as on date is not mentioned in Part- II submitted by Deputy Conservator of Forests, Bhamragarh along with the proposal. Revised Part- II mentioning necessary information shall be submitted.
- x. The Undertaking to bear the cost of CA has not been submitted by the User Agency along with the proposal. The same shall be submitted.
- xi. All the maps submitted along with the proposal is not certified by competent authority in the State Government. Maps certified by concerned DCF needs to be submitted.
- xii. Project layout map is not submitted along with the proposal, the shall be submitted.
- xiii. Certificate ensuring importance of Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 is not submitted along with the proposal. Original FRA-2006 certificate along with documentary evidences in the form of copies of the resolutions of the concerned Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) recording their consent for the proposal and bearing signature of the participants shall be submitted. In addition to this, copies of record of proceedings of the Forest Rights Committee, Sub Divisional Level Committee(s) may also be submitted.
- xiv. Details of employment potential in terms of man days of skilled, semiskilled and unskilled persons on permanent (direct and indirect) and temporary (direct and indirect) basis have not been provided. The same needs to be submitted.

In view of the above, I am directed to request the State Government to submit information on the shortcomings, as indicated above, to this Ministry for further consideration of the proposal for approval under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

This issues with the approval of Regional Officer (Central), Integrated Regional Office, MoEF & CC, Nagpur.
