Sub: EDS regarding Malhar to Marhoon PGMSY Road

Sir,

On the subject cited above, the undersigned wants to draw to your kind attention to the fact that certain deficiencies have been noticed in respect of the Essential Documents submitted by you for the forest clearance of PMGSY road Malhar to Marhoon. Therefore, you are requested to provide the following Essential Documents to this office enabling the undersigned to proceed further in the matter:

1. Coloured Survey of India Toposheet Map of the project site as prescribed under the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003.
2. Copy of the formal approval of the said road by the competent authority.
3. Detailed Muck Disposal Plan may kindly be provided as only the corresponding areas of the dumping sites are mentioned in Form-A Part-I with no mention of the quantity of muck likely to be generated and its eventual dumping site-wise disposal in quantitative terms along with the detail of muck retention structures like retaining wall to be constructed for the purpose as the terrain bears moderate to steep slopes.
4. It has been noticed that there is a conspicuous incongruity between the GPS Map of the road (Marked as red line) and the corresponding fields mentioned in the '**Legend**' which needs to be corrected and the Forest Land, Propriety Land, Dumping Sites and State Land etc. need to be shown in proper colour scheme congruous with the legend used. The corrected hard copies in this regard may also be furnished to this office.
5. Cost Benefit Analysis in respect of the project as per the prescribed format must also be furnished as the forest land proposed for diversion is more than 5 Ha.
