

Renewal of mining lease of Makhroti Slates Quarry over an area of 1.392 ha of forest land in favour of M/s Himachal Slates Stones Mohalla Bangotu, P.O. Chamba, within the jurisdiction of Chamba Forest Division, Distt. Chamba, H.P.

Following shortcomings may be attended by the State Government:

1. The information uploaded at serial No. A-8 (i) is regarding the area returned/surrendered to the forest department from the land diverted earlier which 0.4 ha in this case but the State Govt. uploaded the map and KML of the total area instead of only for 0.4 ha area may upload the same.
2. KML of area proposed for diversion Stat Govt. may upload at C (a) in Online Part-I.
3. The information pertaining to employment generated detail at para E (ii) & (iii) may ask to review and correct in term of mandays.
4. The detail land use plan in 14,000 scale prepared by using DGPS or total station is not uploaded at para M-2 (vi) online Part-I. The map uploaded is not serve any useful purposes.
5. Copy of map of the outer boundary of mining lease are is not uploaded at para M-2 (vii) online part-I the map uploaded is not serve any useful purposes.
6. The maps uploaded in online portal & provided in hard copy of area proposed for diversion are not authenticated by DFO.
7. As per guideline dated 2.08.2017 of MoEF & CC regarding safety zone area. The State Govt. may seek approval of the forest land in safety zone area (7.5 m strip all along the boundary of mining lease area) maintain outside the mining zone area as per guideline dated 13.05.2014 and 4.07.2014 or shall be made inside the mining lease boundary as per guidelines dated 27.05.2015 the state govt. may propose the safety zone area accordingly.
8. The afforestation scheme on degraded forest land to be selected elsewhere measuring one and a half times of the area under safety zone shall also be done at the project cost.
9. The compliance on conditions laid down in the approval of previous vide letter dated 28.05.2013 of this office is required to submit on (xvii) points. The compliance provided at page 10 or 11 for only 7 points.
10. The State Govt. may revise the geo-referenced map of area proposed for diversion including safety zone area in view of point-07 above.
