- 2. Certificate towards payment of NPV in respect of all other mines/ projects of the lessee situated in Keonjhar District and State of Odisha.
- 3. Certificate under FRA-2006 in respect of forest land including resolution copy.

4. Compliance as regards violation committed during ML, if applicable.

- 5. Certificate as regards Status of land (Forest and Non-forest) as on 25.10.1980. (N.B.- The status certificate should be correct and complete in respect of all plots involved in the Mining Lease).
- 6. Pending Court Matters, if any.
