## PROPOSAL NO. FP/UK/ROAD/13065/2015

- 1. Authority letter is not uploaded in the name of applicant in online Par I.
- 2. In the geo referenced digital map of the area proposed for diversion, uploaded at C (iv) Part I online, geo coordinates are shown on Google earth image which does not serve the purpose. May provide/upload scanned copy of geo referenced digital map to the exact scale of the proposed road showing geo coordinates at 200 to 300 m interval along the alignment including all turning points.
- 3. The digital map of area proposed for CA uploaded in online web portal is also found incorrect as provided on google earth map. The State Govt may upload GIS software generated geo referenced digital map of the area proposed for CA which should be 12.574 ha providing geo coordinates at all corner points in shape (polygon/closed area) file.
- 4. The NPV calculation is done for dense forest, however the 0.2 density does not account for dense forest category.
- 5. The hard copy provided by the State Govt contains photo copy of the documents. The State Govt may provide original documents including authenticated copy of Part I, II, III, IV and V as in online web portal to this office through the State Govt.
- 6. In the component wise break up the State Govt did not mentioned the area designated for bridge and muck dumping in online Part I. The State Govt may correct the information in online Part I in component wise break up accordingly.
- 7. In online Part I the details of ownership proof is not uploaded by the State Govt regarding the area proposed for CA. The document uploaded in the place is suitability certificate instead of ownership proof.
- 8. The cost benefit analysis is not provided in the format prescribed in the guideline of FCA Annexure VI (B) and VI (C). The State Govt may provide and upload the correct cost benefit analysis and quantify the same in monetary terms.
- 9. In Part II of the proposal the CF mentioned the numbers of beneficiaries are 150, however in the hard copy of the proposal the numbers of beneficiaries are 250 families and 1150 population may need necessary correction.
