The proposal submitted by the User Agency in the reference 1st cited for for diversion of 0.246 ha. of Forest land in Karuttamalai RF of Odugathur Range in Vellore Forest Division for laying underground Optical Fiber Communication (OFC) cable under section-2 of Forest Conservation Act 1980 has been forwarded by the District Forest Officer, Vellore by uploading the Part-II Form-A.

The area proposed for the diversion to an extent of 0.246 ha of forest land which falls in Karuttamalai Reserved Forest of Odugathur Range for laying underground OFC along the road side of Assanampattu to Alangayam road section across Karuttamalai Reserve Forest. This road is a State Highways road which passes through Karuttamalai RF. The Airtel proposed to lay the underground OFC cable to a length of 4.10 Km. to a width of 60 cm. and to a depth of 1.65 mts. The proposed alignment of the OFC cable to be laid in the forest area is along the State Highways Road which passes through Karuttamalai Reserve Forest.

As per the field conditions for a width of 60 mts. a depth of 1.0 mts. is sufficient. The proposed depth of 1.65 mts. is too deep, which is unnecessary. The same User Agency has proposed 1.0 mt. depth for laying underground OFC cable. Hence a revised proposal may be submitted.
