Dear Sir,

We wish to inform you that Hal Settlement was published in the year 1992-93 according to which Sukinda Chromite Mine is having forest land of 73.697 ha and non-forest land of 332.303 ha out of the 406 ha of the mining lease-hold area. Company has already been granted with Stage-II forest clearance over 73.697 ha of forest land as per Hal RoR vide MoEF, Govt. of India letter no. 8-78/96-FC, dated 27.01.1998. Now with the MMDR (Amendment) Act 2015 coming into force and subsequently with MoEF&CC Circular dated 01.04.2015, the above mentioned earlier granted forest clearance has now deemed to be extended till 31.03.2020. The Company has also been granted with Stage-I approval for 73.697 ha for the renewal period vide letter dated 03.11.2014 of MoEF&CC along with one year working permission.

However, with the MoEF&CC circular dated 10.03.2015, the total extent of forest land has now been estimated to be 404.669 ha out of 406 ha of the mining lease-hold as per Sabik ROR i.e. as on 25.10.1980. NPV over entire forest land of 404.669 ha has already been paid.

Thus, in accordance with the MoEF&CC circular dated 10.03.2015, Company is now submitting forest diversion proposal over balance forest land of 330.972 ha. It is pertinent to mention here that the mining operation is going on since 1960 and the entire mining lease area of 406 ha is broken up much prior to 25.10.1980.

Forest Diversion Proposal in Form-A was submitted online having reference no. FP/OR/MIN/16331/2015 and now we are submitting the Signed copy of Proposal (Form-A downloaded from MoEF&CC website) towards acceptance of the proposal. Further, we are submitting herewith Forest Diversion Proposal in hard copies (six nos.) over 330.972 ha of



forest land as on 25.10.1980 with necessary annexure complete in all respects. We request that the said proposal may kindly be considered for obtaining approval of MoEF&CC under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
