**PSC scrutinized the proposal and found following observations-**

1. In the present case In-Principle approval was accorded by Gol vide letter dtd. 19.3.1999 and Final approval vide letter dated 21.9.2000 for 10 years.
2. MoEF & CC vide letter dt. 1.10.2010 informed that the lease falls in Aravalli range and the renewal of lease for 20 years w.e.f. 27.11.1999 by Mines Department on 22.7.2003 was not strictly permissible. Further MoEF & CC directed UA to obtain permission of the Hon'ble SC to enable the Ministry to consider his request for extension / modification of period for forest clearance beyond 10 years. But no such permission / information is submitted by the applicants.
3. As per MOEF & CC letter dated 1.4.15, 1.5.15 & 30.11.17 the validity of forest clearance granted for diversion of forest land shall be for a period co-terminus with the period of mining lease as deemed extended under the Rules. As per the record available with department and AME Tonk letter No. 1032 dt. 25.2.2015 the lease period is up-to 5.10.2033.
4. MoEF & CC vide letter dt. 7.7.2022 sought some additional information including status of paid NPV and asked to clarify whether the said lease falls in the list of 261 mining leases submitted to Hon'ble Supreme Court regarding the Aravalli range. No information has been provided by applicants in this regard.
5. As per GoR circular dtd.17.7.15 Mines department is the Nodal Department for the MMDR Act, 1957 and MMDR Amendment Act, 2015. ADMG (Mines) is the Nodal Officer. So all mining related proposal are to be submitted by Mining department but in the present case the lease holder submitted the proposal.

**After due discussion and based on above observations the PSC decided to seek clarification from the applicant whether they have been authorized by the Mining Department to apply for renewal of their diversion proposal or not? and to submit the proposal accordingly.**

DCF Alwar vide letter No. 2475 dated 1.3.25 has informed that in Segment No.3 which is between village Lapala and Baloj, the alignment as marked in KML file and other superimposed map is not verified. Further DCF has directed UA to mark the alignment of TL on ground so that tree counting can be done accordingly. **Based on the remarks given by DCF Alwar the proposed forest area is not verified on ground and hence tree counting is not carried out. The matter was discussed with representatives of Proponent and they informed PSC that due to change in alignment the proposed forest area may alter and accordingly information of the proposal will change. After due discussion PSC decided to return the proposal to UA with a direction to resubmit the complete proposal within the stipulated time as per Van (Sanrakshan evam Samvardhan) Rules 2023.**

**PSC scrutinized the proposal and found following observations-**

1. Earlier GoI vide letter dt. 7/11.5.2004 accorded final approval for 38.04 Ha of forest land in favour of 27 lease holder and for remaining 8 lease holders In-principle approval granted vide letter dt. 21.2.2000 was cancelled.
2. None of the lease holder has deposited NPV amount.
3. MoEF & CC, vide letter dated 5/6.07.2022 sought some additional information like lease wise status of validity of leases with documentary evidences, Number of lease holders who are operating mines at present, Status of progressive reclamation plan of mined out area etc. No such information has been provided by the applicants.

4. The proposal was also discussed in 38<sup>th</sup> PSC meeting held on 26.11.2024 and information related to distance of mines from Ramgarh Vish Dhari Tiger Reserve, Bundi was sought. In this regard DCF RVTR, Bundi has informed that the mines are at a distance between 3.87 Km to 4.3 km from the core boundary of RVTR and are within 10 km of ESZ boundary as per MoEF & CC letter dated 16.7.2020.

No one from proponent was present in the meeting and hence no information could be made available to PSC. After based on above observations and discussion, PSC decided to include this proposal in the next PSC.

**PSC scrutinized the proposal and found following observations-**

1. The Main Canal Road along which the proposed pipe line has to be laid, is under jurisdiction with GREF. Since the proposed pipe line will cross the road, NOC from GREF is required.
2. As per Kml file submitted for NFL for CA, the area is overlapping with the plantation area (forest block) and also overlapping with the existing road. It seems that coordinates of the uploaded Kml file are not correct. Further SMC works in the form of trenches / V-ditch are visible. Needs clarification and rectification by UA.
3. In point No. 20 of Part-I for "Presence of Schedule I species within the study area" UA remarked "0", while Chinkara, the state animal is roaming in the area. Needs rectification by UA.
4. The originating point of the project starts from "plantation" taken by Forest department in earlier years, at "Escape channel". UA to clarify the legal status of such area from DCF IGNP St-II Jaisalmer.

**PSC after due discussion decided to raise EDS with a direction to UA to provide reply to the observations made above and submit the complete proposal within the permissible time limit as per provisions of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023.**

**PSC scrutinized the proposal and found following observations-**

1. The lease period of ML No. 613/1990 is from 1.4.1961 to 31.03.2025.
2. As per 8(2) of MMDR Act, 2015 on and from the date of the commencement of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Amendment Act, 2015, all mining leases shall be granted for the period of fifty years. And as per 8(2) on the expiry of the lease period, the lease shall be put up for auction as per the procedure specified in this Act. Since the lease period in this case is expiring on 31.3.2025 the validity of the lease has to be clarified by mining department as per provisions of MMDR Act, 2015.
3. As per MOEF & CC letter dated 1.4.15, 1.5.15 & 30.11.17 the validity of forest clearance granted for diversion of forest land shall be for a period co-terminus with the period of mining lease as deemed extended under the Rules and there would be no renewal of any Mining Lease in future.
4. Regarding violation of FCA, 1980 detail report has been sought by Nodal Officer from CCF Jaipur and DCF Alwar. Regarding this issue DCF Alwar informed PSC that some clarification is being sought from mining department and the same is not provided by the mining department.
5. As per GoR circular dtd.17.7.15 Mines department is the Nodal Department for the MMDR Act, 1957 and MMDR Amendment Act, 2015. ADMG (Mines) is the Nodal Officer. So all mining related proposal are to be submitted by Mining department but in the present case the lease holder submitted the proposal.

3. In point No. 10.1 of Part-I, "Whether Project or a part thereof is located within a Protected Area" it is remarked as "YES" then why in point Nos  
10.1.1.1 Area located outside the protected area

**PSC scrutinized the proposal and found following observations-**

1. During meeting representatives of the proponent informed PSC that elevated road is proposed within the area of Sariska Tiger Reserve. In this regard PSC directed UA to provide complete details in the document related to "Justification". Further DCF WL STR informed PSC that proposed ramp sites are to be reconsidered by the proponent and a few places the alignment has to be discussed with DCF WL STR.
2. In point No. 7.1 CA is proposed in NFL while regarding its availability it is remarked as "No". UA to clarify and it is required to submit necessary documents.
3. Layout Plan / cross section of the proposed road is not submitted.
4. Khasra wise and segment wise area calculation (for both forest and non-forest) is not furnished.
5. Certified copies of Zamabandi of the land (for both forest and non-forest) under consideration in the project is not provided.




